A strong winter storm dropped 6 to 10 inches of snow across much of northern Illinois, with a few sites reporting up to a foot of snow. The heaviest snow fell from Rockford east-southeast into the heart of the Chicago Metropolitan area. Some of the heaviest snow reports include: 11.8 inches one mile east-northeast of Homer Glen; 11.7 inches two miles southeast of Yorkville; 11.3 inches 5 miles west-northwest of Orland Park; 10.2 inches in DeKalb; 10.1 inches around Elgin; 10.0 inches in Elburn; 10.0 inches one mile southeast of Orland Hills; 10.0 inches one mile southwest of Palos Park; 10.0 inches two miles south-southeast of Montgomery; 10.0 inches two miles east of Lily Lake; 9.9 inches in North Riverside; 9.9 inches in Willow Springs; 9.8 inches one mile south-southwest of La Grange Park; 9.8 inches one mile south-southeast of Westmont; 9.7 inches in Willowbrook; 9.7 inches two miles southwest of Burr Ridge; 9.6 inches three miles southwest of Midway Airport; 8.5 inches six miles west southwest of Marseilles; 8.0 inches in Capron; 8.0 inches in Rochelle; 7.6 inches two miles north of Buffalo Grove; 7.5 inches in Woodstock; 7.2 inches in Polo; 6.9 inches one mile east southeast of Pontiac; 6.7 inches in Bourbonnais and 6.5 inches three miles south of Earlville. At the official climate locations, Rockford Airport received 9.6 inches, Chicago O'Hare Airport measured 9.2 inches, and the NWS in Romeoville measured 8.7 inches.

The highest snowfall reports include: 10.5 inches in Valparaiso; 10.4 inches one mile south of Porter; 10.0 inches one mile east-northeast of Wheatfield; 9.5 inches in Lake Village; 9.0 inches in Crown Point; 9.0 inches in St. John; 9.0 inches one mile east-southeast of Portage; 9.0 inches in Rensselaer; 8.0 inches around De Motte; 7.8 inches one mile west-northwest of Dyer; 7.7 inches four miles northeast of Hebron; 7.6 inches two miles west-southwest of Schererville; and 7.6 inches two miles north-northeast of Lakes of the Four Seasons.
