A clipper system dropped heavy snow during the morning commute on March 23rd. Snowfall rates of 1 to 2 inches per hour were common with this system. A corridor of 5 to 7 inches fell across portions of far northeastern Illinois. The highest snow measurements include 6.4 inches near Elk Grove Village (Cook); 6.3 inches in Bull Valley (McHenry); and 6.1 inches in St. Charles (Kane).
