Heavy rain caused flooding across parts of Cook county and the City of Chicago. Six to seven inches of standing water was reported on north Lincoln Avenue near the intersection at Peterson. A runway at Midway Airport was closed due to standing water. Minor street flooding was reported at the intersection of Ogden Avenue and First Avenue in Brookfield. Rainfall totals included 2.02 inches in Berwyn; 1.75 inches 4 miles northeast of Brookfield; 1.53 inches at Midway Airport and 1.37 inches at Chicago O'Hare Airport.
