Key Messages

- Two rounds of wintry weather expected:
 - Monday Night - Tuesday
 - Wednesday - Wednesday Night
- **Snow** is the primary precipitation type with the first round, with more **sleet** and **freezing rain** midweek with the second round.
- Light to moderate accumulations of wintry precipitation expected to cause travel impacts.

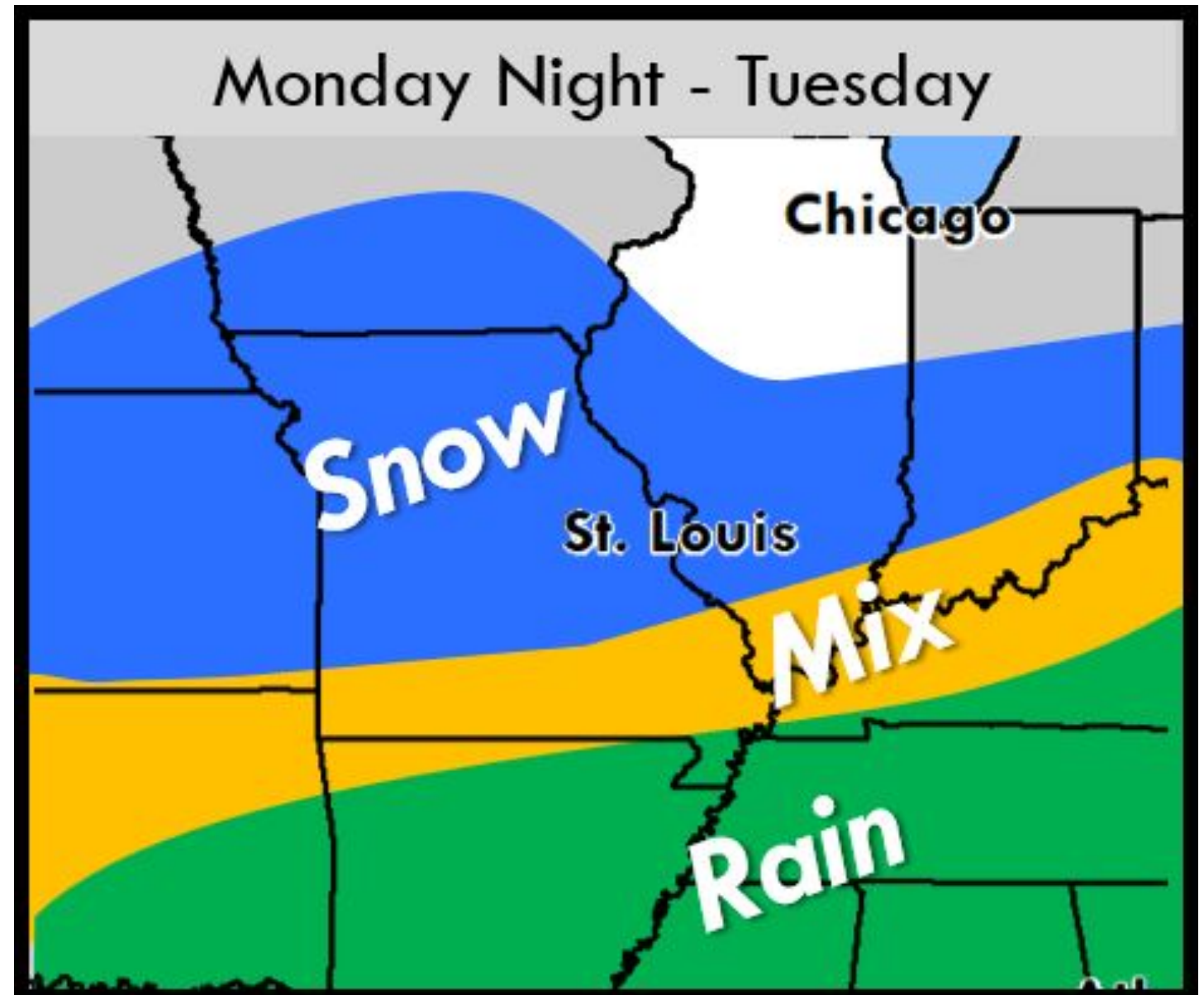


What Has Changed

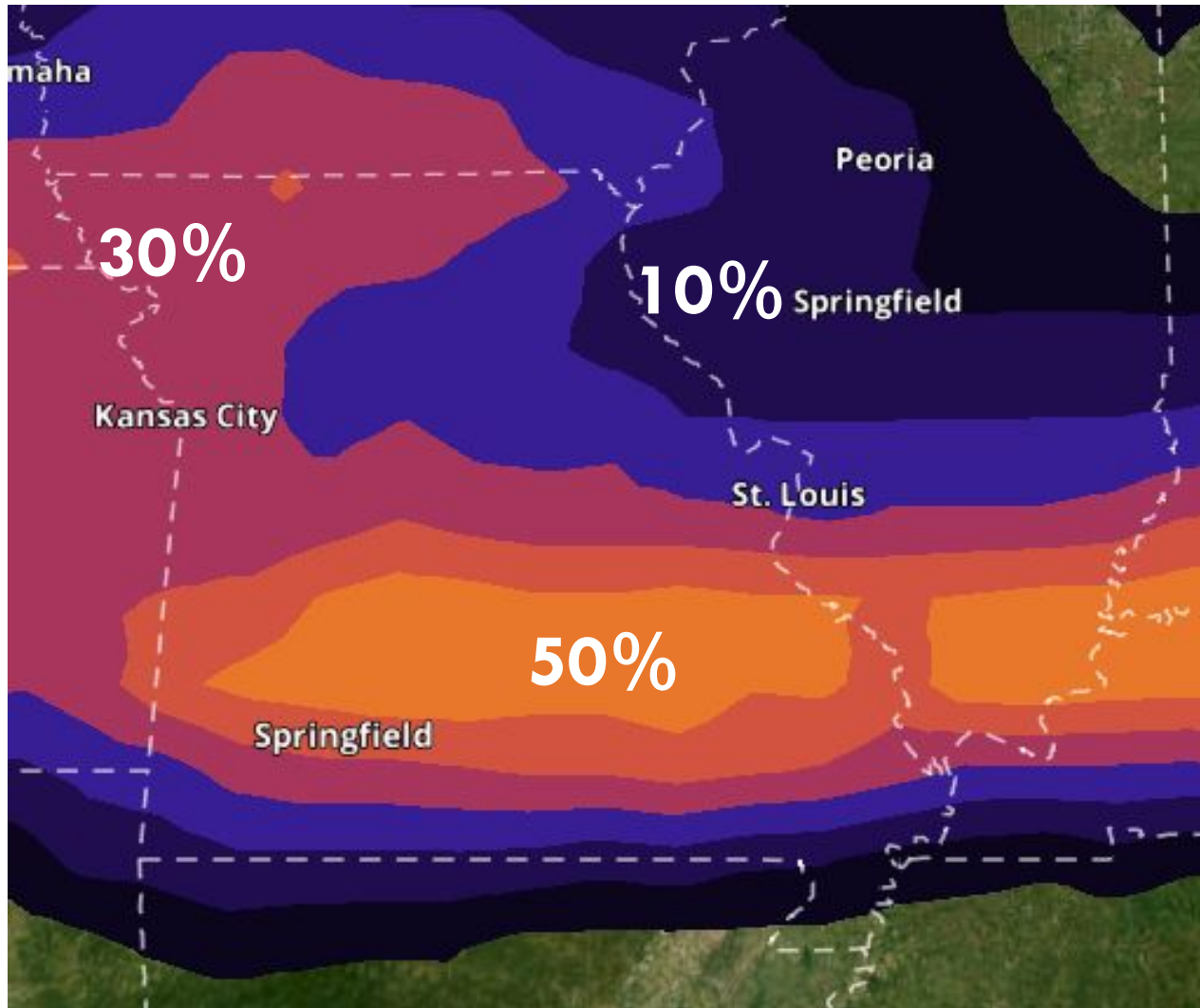

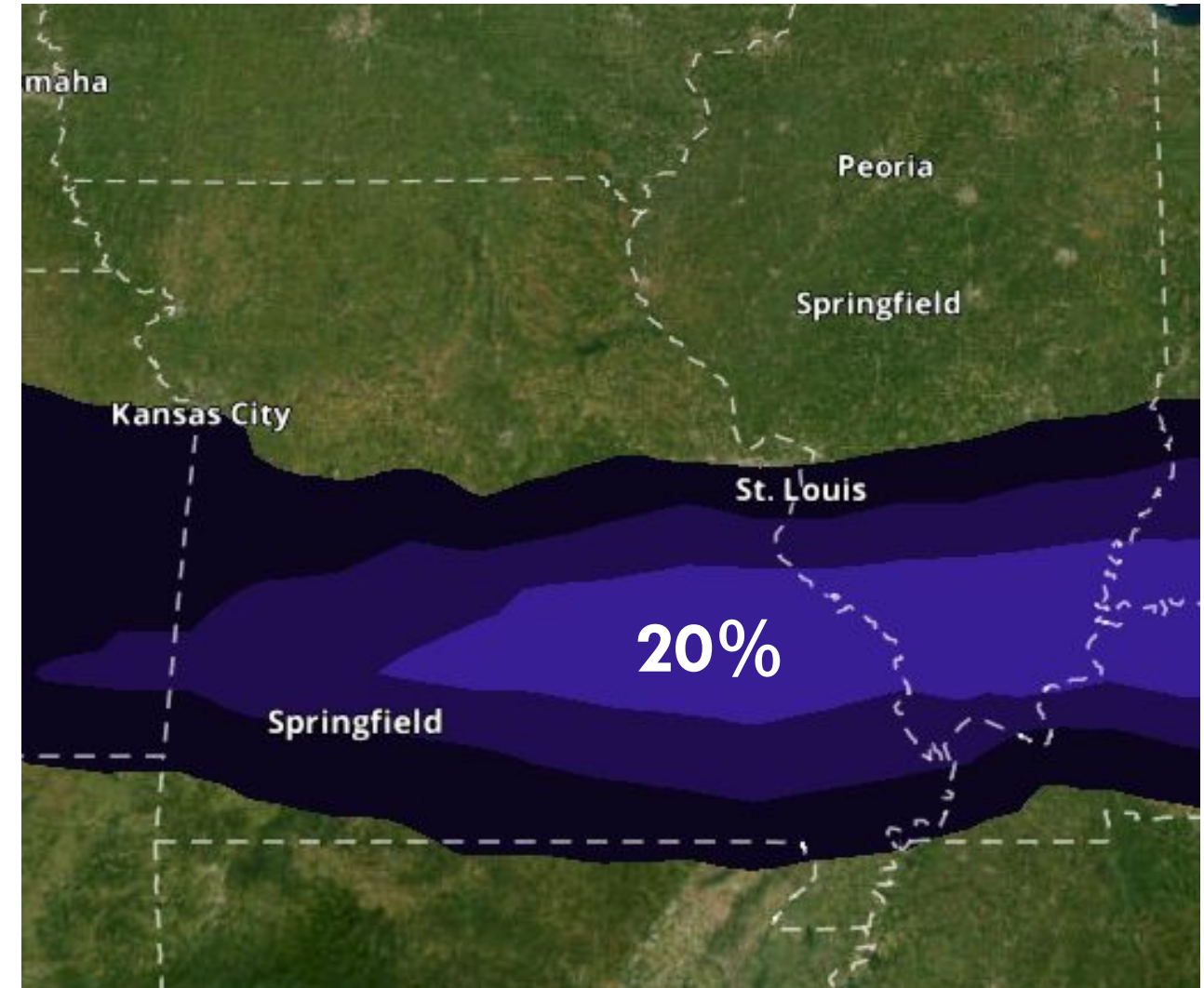

Probability of Exceeding 3" Snow Accumulation



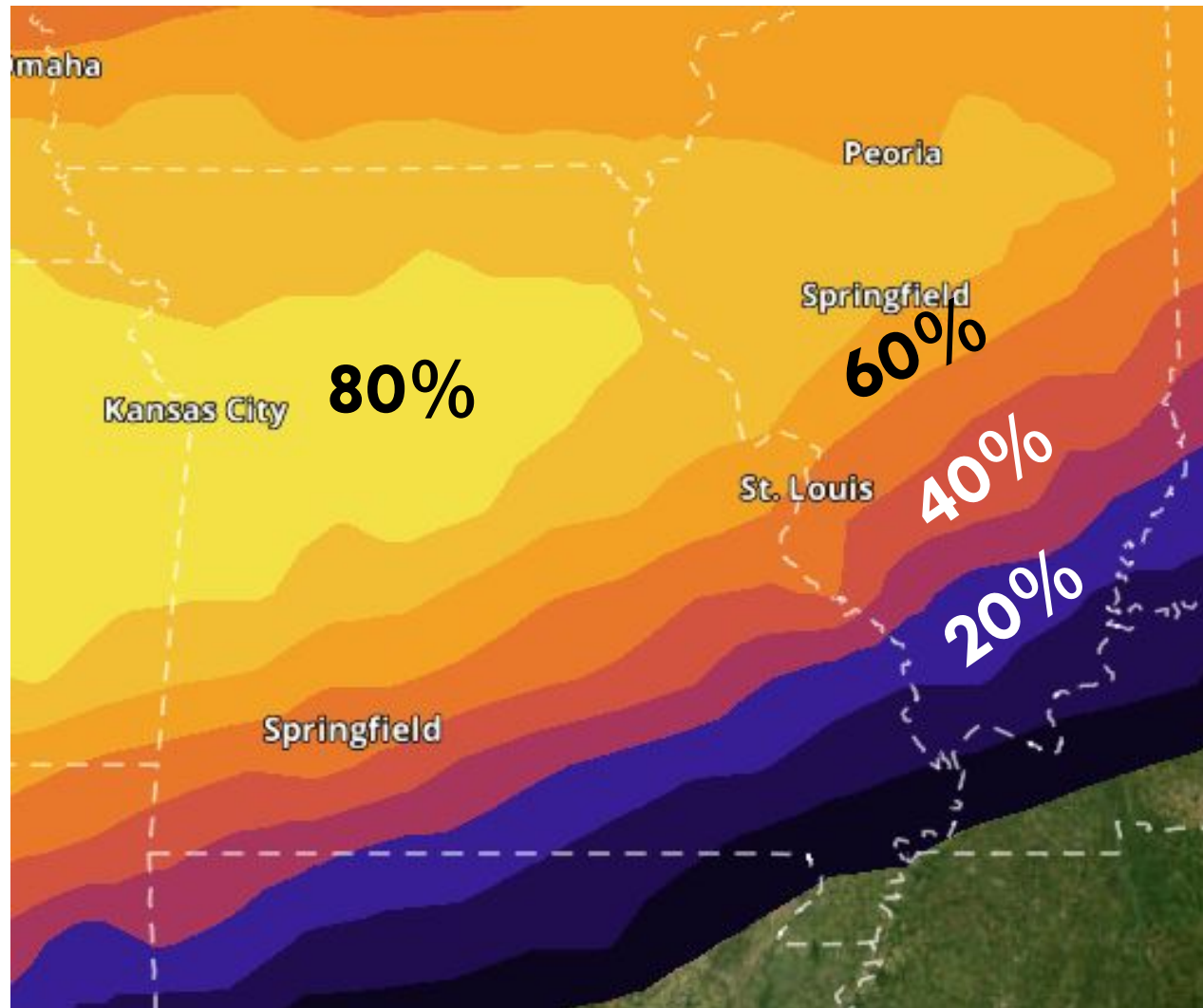

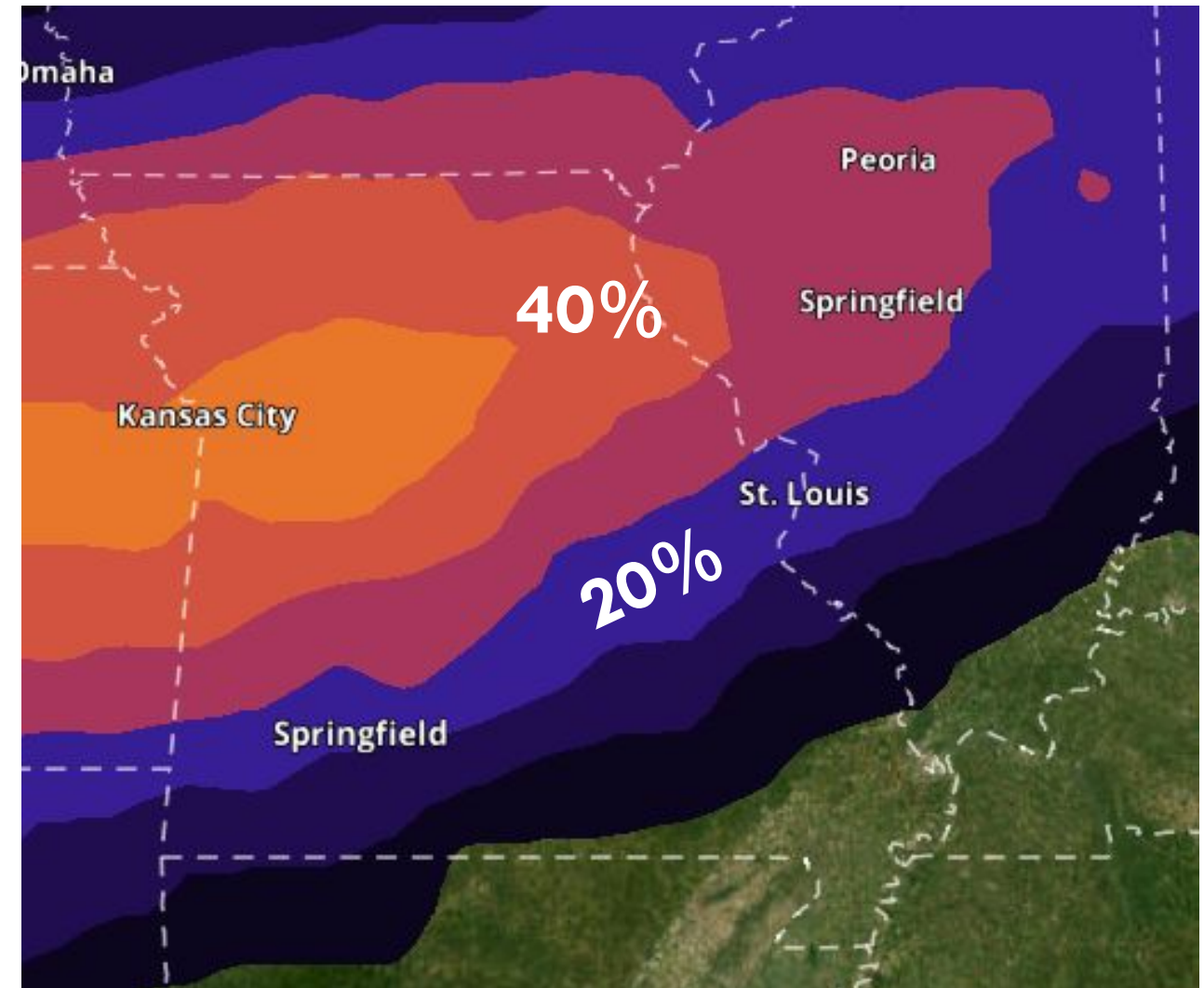

What We Are Confident Will Happen?

- **Amounts** - Total precipitation amounts are expected to be light with the first round, but a bit heavier for midweek.
- **Timing** - There is increasing confidence that there will be two distinct rounds of wintry weather, one on Monday night/Tuesday and another Wednesday/Wednesday night.

What is Still Uncertain?

- **Precipitation Type** - **Snow** is the primary precipitation type expected with the first round, with more **sleet** and **freezing rain/rain** for the midweek event. Exactly where the transition zones set up for the midweek event are more uncertain.
- **Locations** - The first round (Mon Night - Tue) of wintry weather may feature more localized bands of snow with other areas receiving little/to snow. Where those bands set up is not very clear. The second round (Wed) is more likely to feature a much broader area of precipitation.
