Upcoming Radar Outages and Maintenance

What is Happening?

The National Weather Service radar will be down for 8 days to give the radar generator some maintenance.

When?

October 1st through 8th.

Why?

This is being done as part of a bigger project known as the WSR-88D Service Life Extension Project. This project provides a refresh and overhaul of some of the radar components to help extend the life of the Lubbock radar and all of its components for another 20 years.

What's Next?

In late November the radar pedestal will be replaced and the radar will be down for about two weeks. Check out a pedestal replacement time lapse [here](#).

What If There is Weather?

In the event there is weather meteorologists at the National Weather Service office in Lubbock will utilize surrounding radars as well as satellites, multi-radar multi-sensors and the West Texas Mesonet to continue operations.
