A strong cold front was moving through the region during the evening of the fifth. Mid level showers had developed behind the frontal boundary and contributed to strong downdrafts across the central and southeastern Texas Panhandle. Winds behind the cold front were briefly enhanced by the downdrafts and led to a high wind gust at Lesley (Hall County) of 58 mph recorded by the Texas Tech University West Texas mesonet.

Widespread dense fog spread over the region on the morning of the 27th. An accident involving two vehicles occurred about one mile southeast of Slaton (Lubbock County) along US Highway 84. Law enforcement were investigating the crash when a tractor-trailer jack knifed, swerved off the road, and slid onto its side. The tractor-trailer collided with several vehicles on the side of the road and in the ditch. A Texas State trooper was hit and another driver was pinned inside of his vehicle. Both individuals sustained unknown injuries. The incident was captured on video by a photographer with KCBD-TV.
