The river gauge at Martinsburg at Opequon Creek reached their flood stage of 10 feet. The river crested at 10.70 feet at 10:00 EST. Floodwaters began to cover Douglas Grove Road east of Martinsburg. A portion of Bowers Road is also flooded. Low lying areas near the creek begin to flood. Water also began to cover the stream access point at Stone Bridge.

The river gauge in Jones Spring on Back Creek reached their flood stage of 11 feet. The river crested at 11.06 feet at 9:30 EST. Dry Run Road begins to flood. Water approaches Daisy Lane.

Low pressure moved across eastern NC to the Delmarva peninsula and easterly flow allowed moisture to advect into the Mid-Atlantic Region. Moderate to heavy rainfall occurred across the Upper Potomac Basin and led to isolated areas of river flooding.
