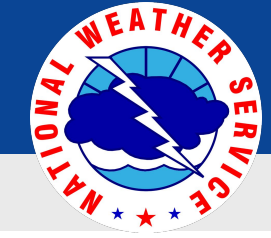

- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms capable of producing damaging wind gusts are possible this afternoon and evening

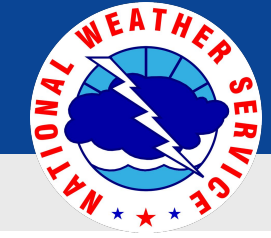

- No hazardous weather is expected at this time.

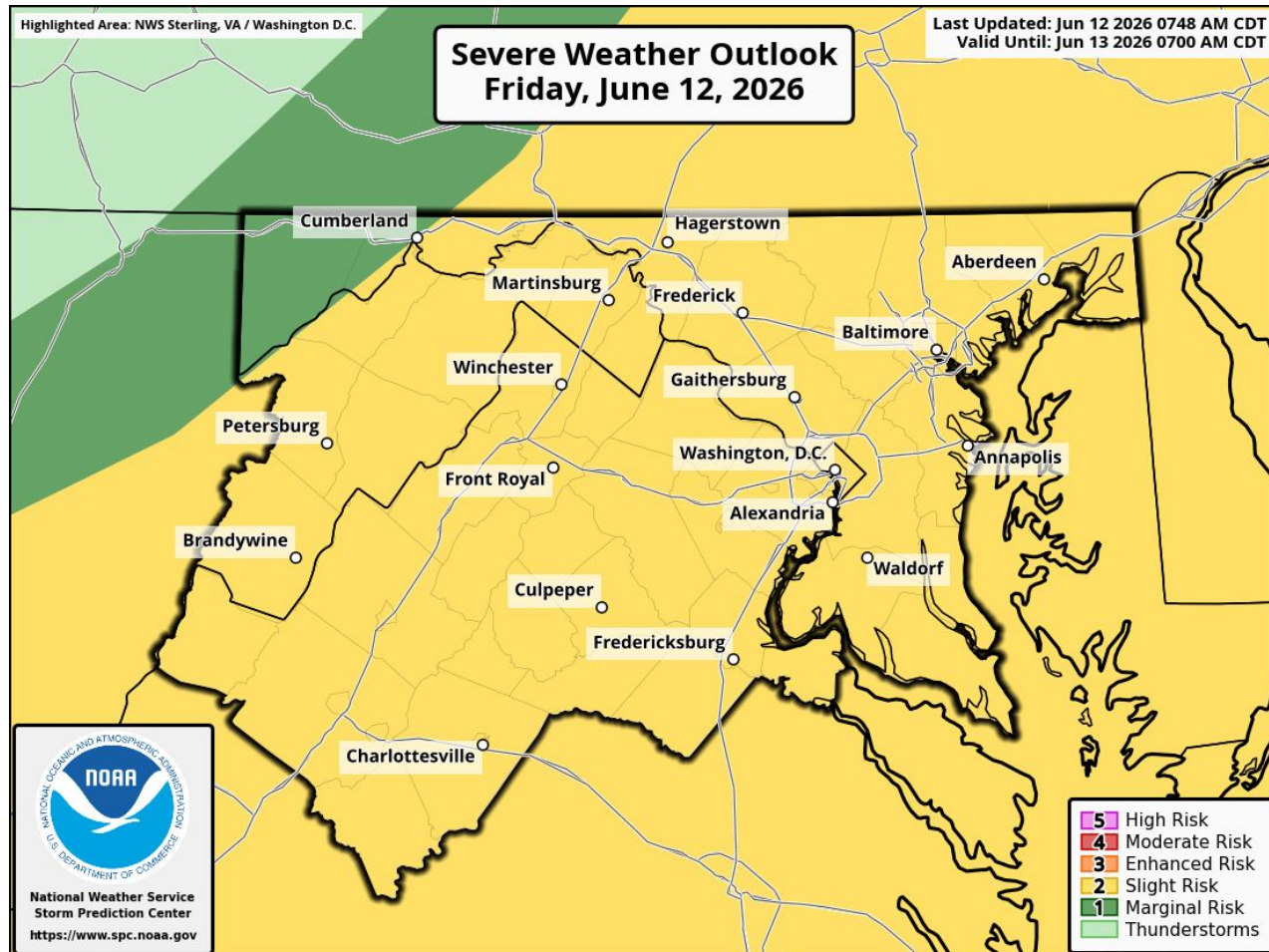

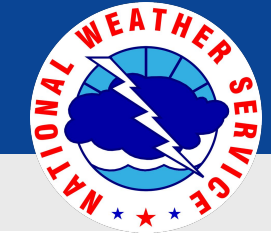


Potential Impact

- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms are expected this afternoon and evening.
- The primary severe weather hazard will be damaging wind gusts with 60 and 70 mph gusts possible. Isolate large hail is possible.
- Highest chances for severe thunderstorms will be along and east of the Blue Ridge Mtns between 2 and 7 pm



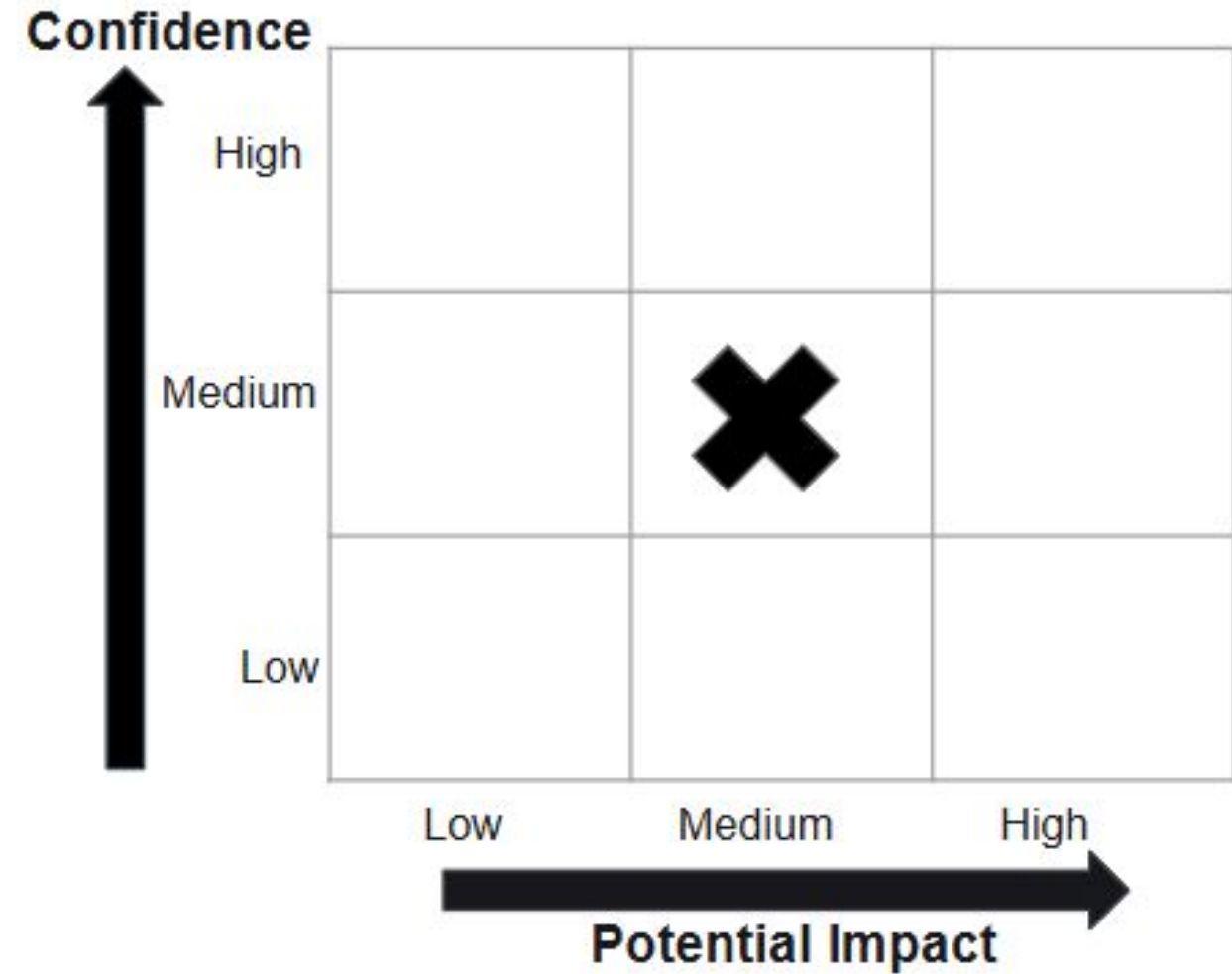
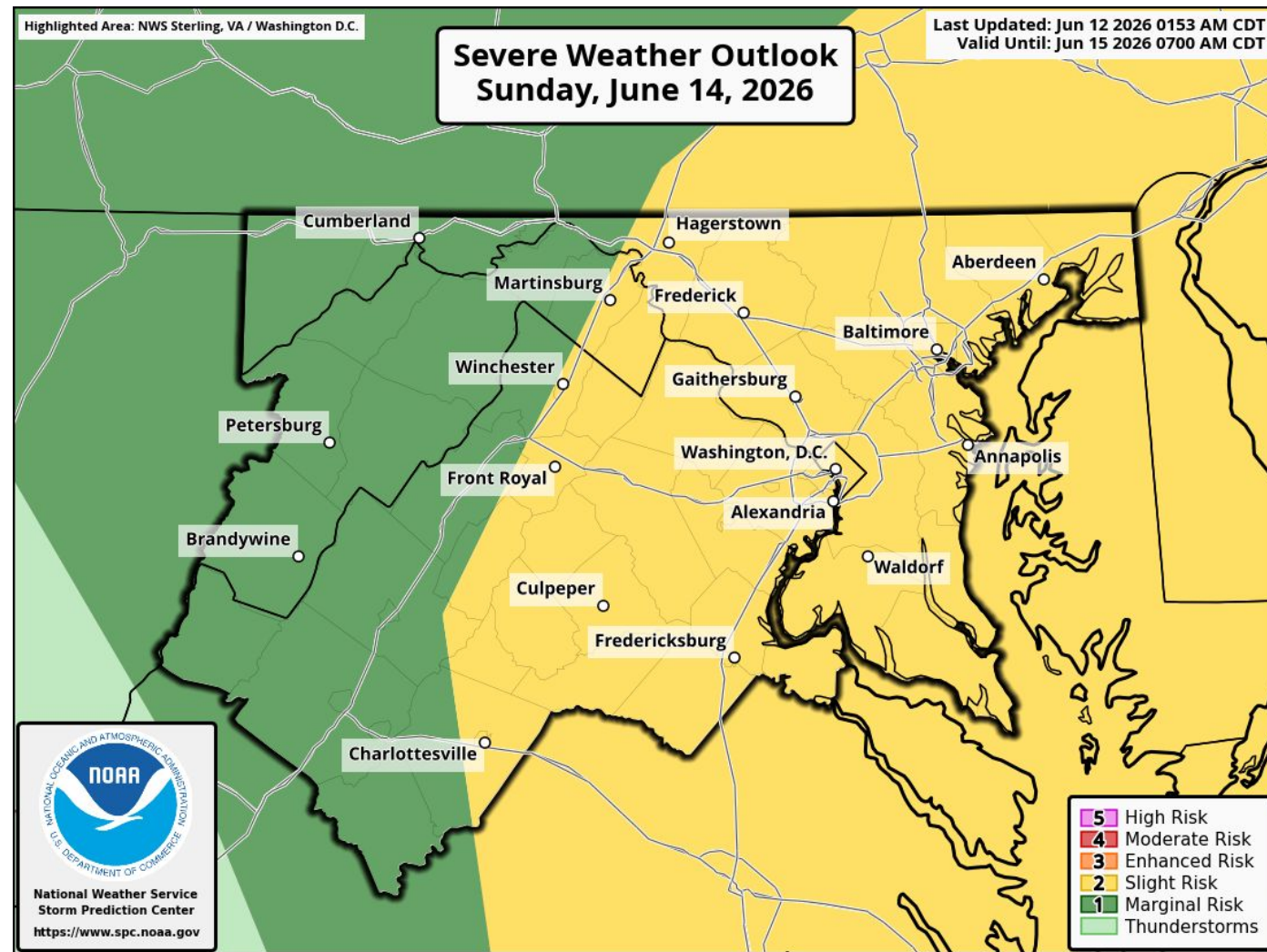




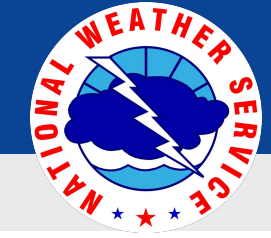

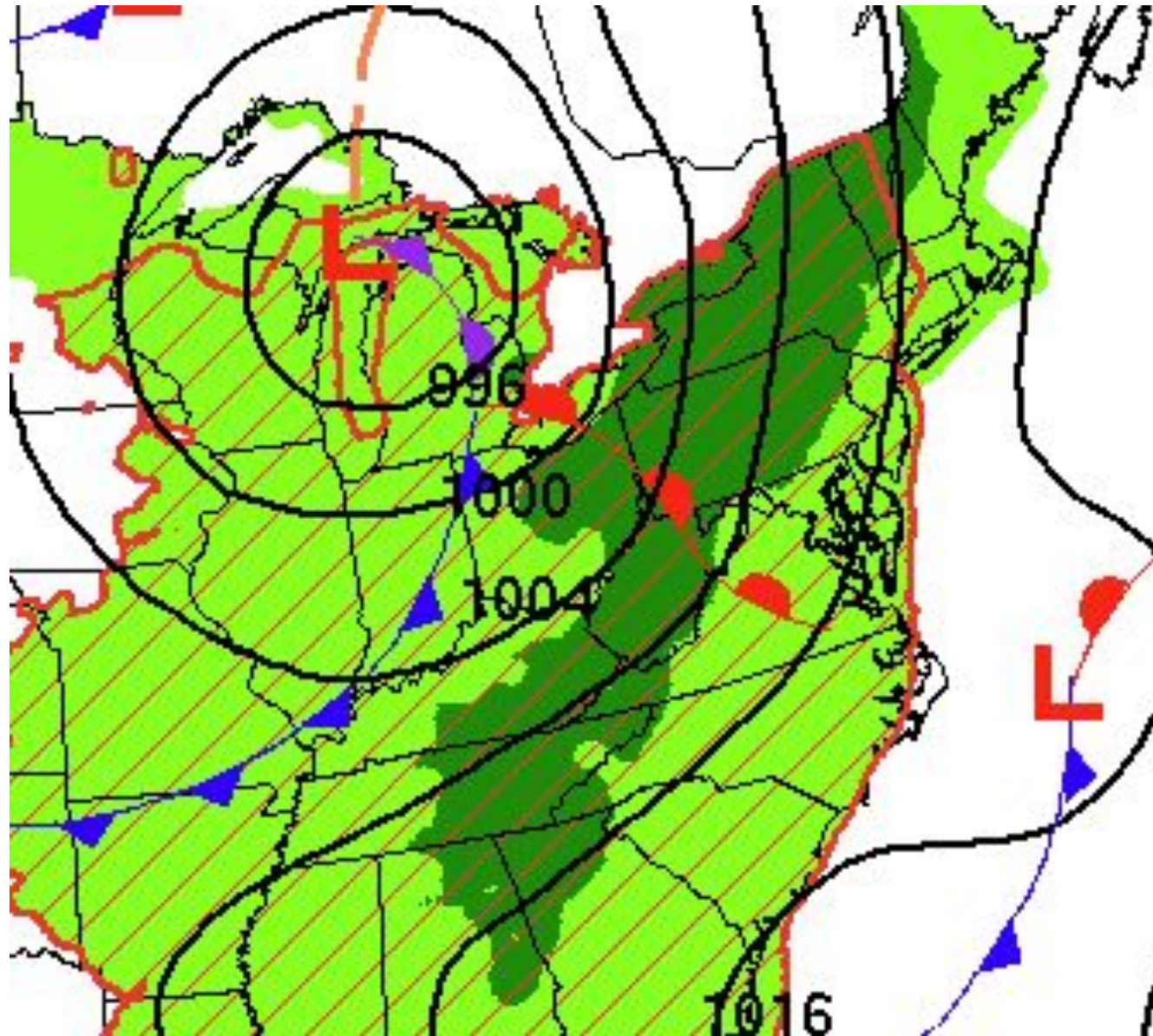
- A frontal passage combined with hot and humid conditions will bring the threat for scattered strong to severe thunderstorms on Sunday
- Main severe hazards: Damaging winds, large hail and tornadoes will be possible



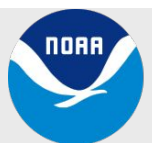
# Thunderstorms return next week

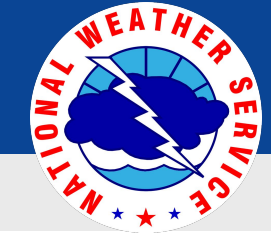
June 12, 2026

- A frontal passage combined with the return of warm and humid conditions will bring the next chance for possible strong storms on Thursday of next week

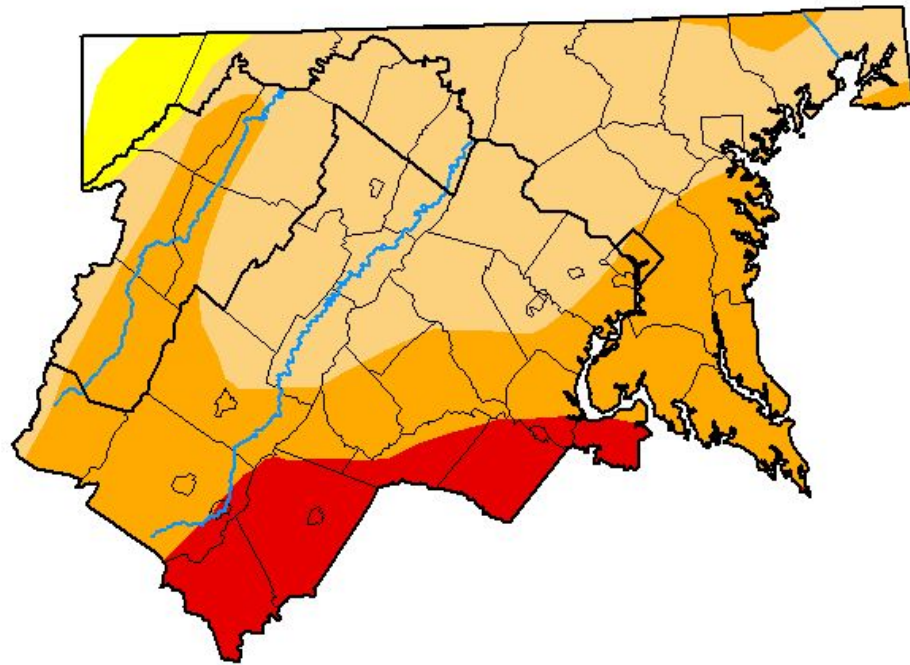

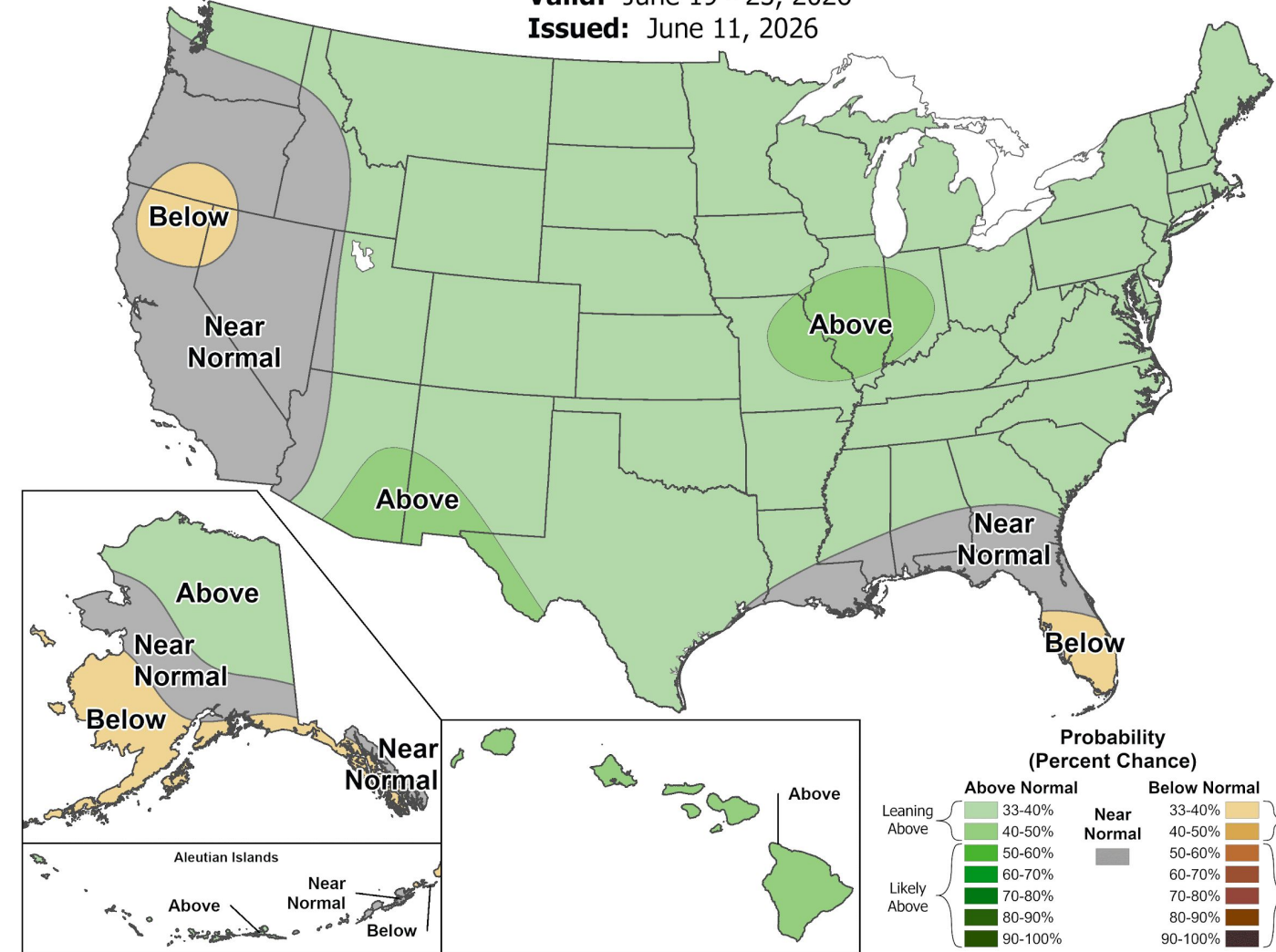
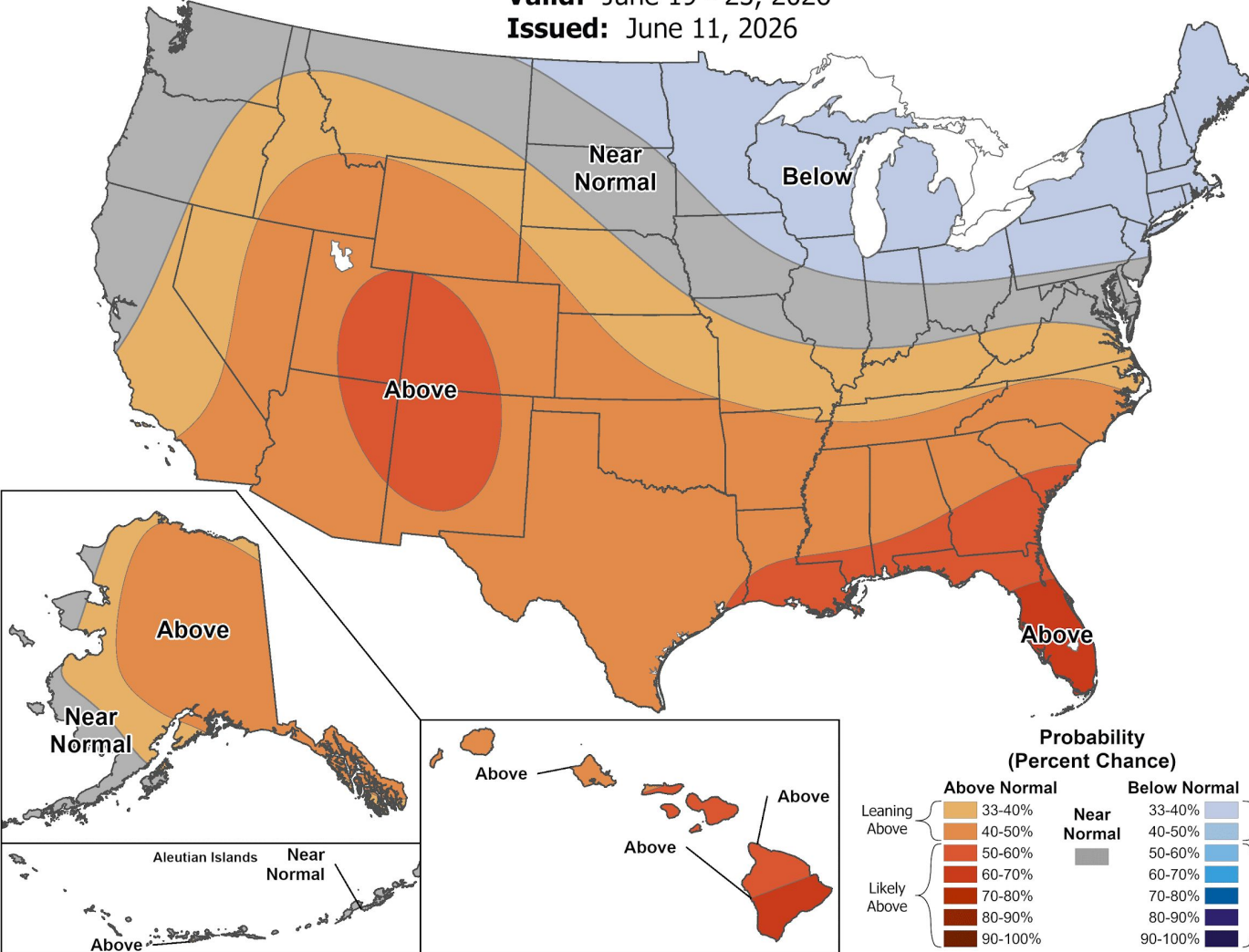
## 8-14 Day Temperature Outlook

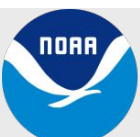
## 8-14 Day Precipitation Outlook

Leaning above normal rainfall

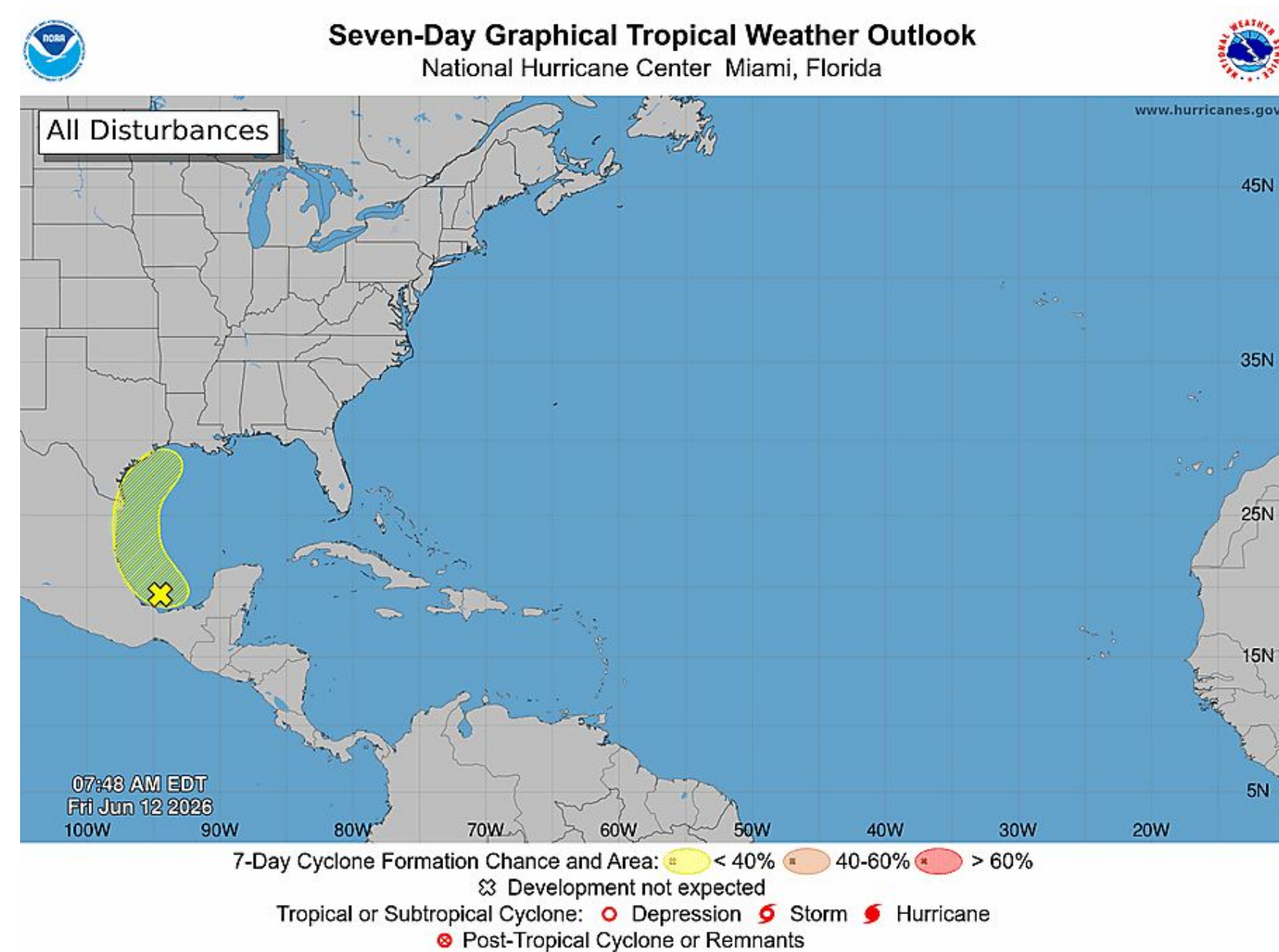

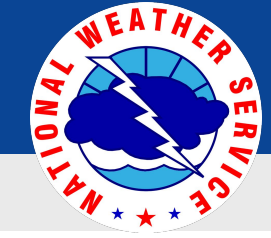
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## 7 Day Outlook
