During the early afternoon of Wednesday June 18th, a cluster of severe thunderstorms crossed central Maryland between Washington and Baltimore . One storm briefly produced a tornado in northwestern Anne Arundel County Maryland , in southern Odenton.				
At 2:15 PM EDT, a tornado touched down in the community of Chapel Village , just south of the southern end of Chapel Hill Boulevard. There, along the north edge of a water retention pond, it uprooted two trees. It continued southeast and crossed the 800 block of Sunny Chapel Road. Here is where the damage was most intense. Kettle Run entered minor flood stage. At this level, a foot of water is flowing over the lowest point of Valley View Drive.

A slow moving area of low pressure spawned showers and thunderstorms during the afternoon and evening hours of June 26th. These thunderstorms were slow moving and produced localized rainfall amounts of two to four inches in an hour or two, which resulted in flash flooding.
