Numerous supercell thunderstorms moved across Arkansas from the evening of April 13th into the early morning hours of April 14th. These storms produced multiple weak tornadoes and damaging wind gusts across Arkansas. The tornadoes and damaging wind gusts produced primarily light structural damage, and one of the hardest hit areas was a nursing home near Mountain Home that was heavily damaged by 85 mph straight line winds.
