A strong Arctic cold front moved across Arkansas on the night of November 31st and the morning of December 1st. Moisture lingering behind the cold front resulted in some light freezing rain, freezing drizzle and even a little sleet and snow across northern Arkansas, especially the northern two rows of counties. The only travel problems reported in the Little Rock County Warning Area were on U.S. 65 in Boone County, from Harrison north to the Missouri border.
