Rain measured 3.15 inches and fell in 3.5 hours from 7 pm to 1030 pm.

Early on the 21st, a few trees were toppled by gusty winds at Sturkie (Fulton County). As the day progressed, the deluge arrived. Later in the afternoon and evening, water was over Highway 60 near Sweet Home (Perry County). On the south side of Cabot (Lonoke County), a neighborhood flooded with water in several homes.

As rain moved in on the 21st, high temperatures in the northwest were only in the 70s. That was the case at Harrison (Boone County). Away from the rain (in the south/east), highs were in the 90s. It was 96 degrees at El Dorado (Union County).
