

Regional Climate Summary

November 2018

Midland/Odessa, TX
Issued May 13, 2021 4:52 AM CT



This November was much drier compared to the last few months. Most rainfall totals across the region were below 0.50" which ranged from 5% to 50% of normal. Carlsbad and Midland were especially dry and ranked amongst the top 25 driest November's on record. Average temperatures this month were on the cool side ranging 2-6°F below normal region-wide. A strong cold front on the 13th-14th brought the first widespread hard freeze of the Fall season to the area. November ended with a good ol' fashioned wind storm on the 30th. Winds gusted over 50 mph in the plains and 70 mph in the mountains and created a dusty mess.
