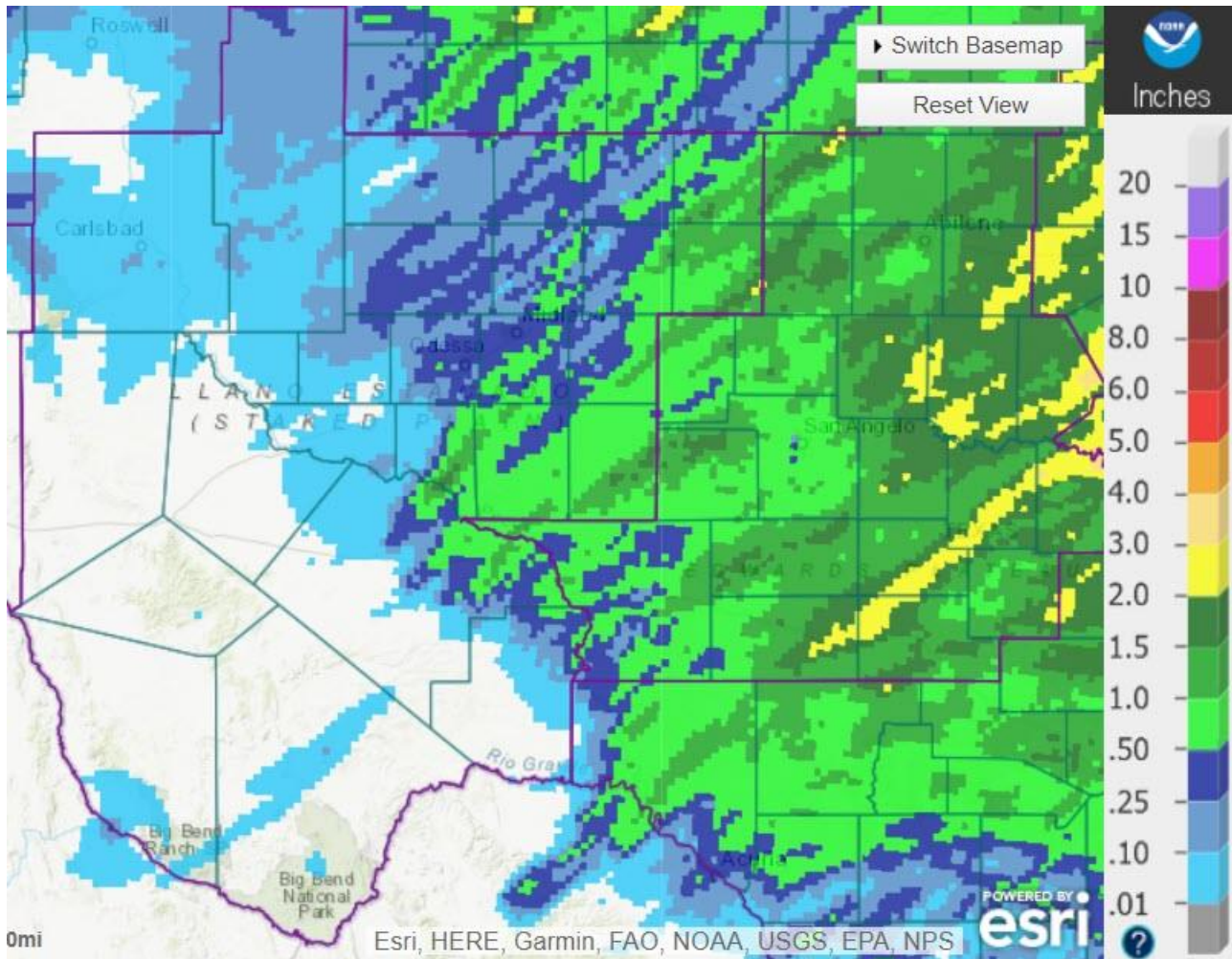

March Precipitation

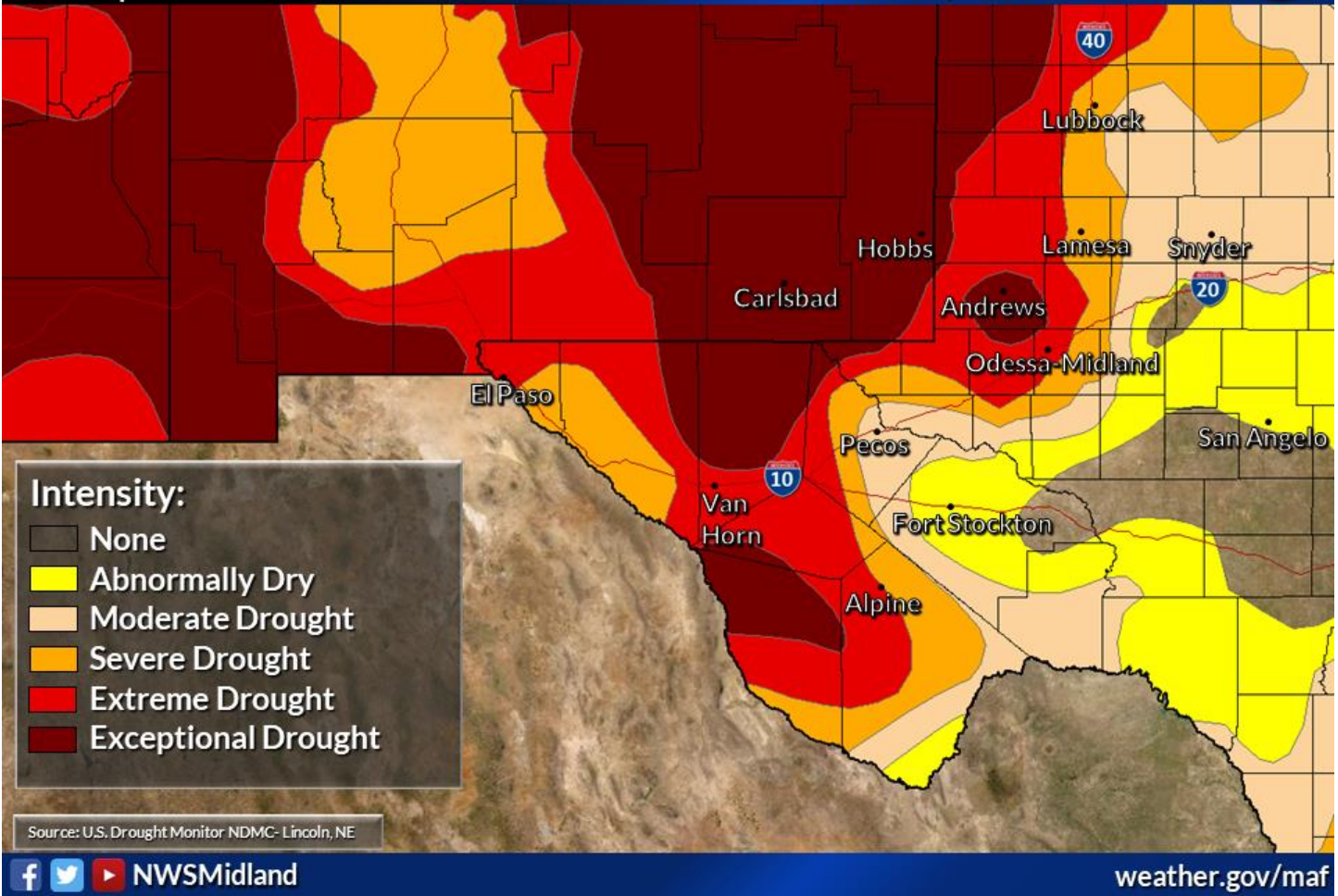
Normal March precipitation for Midland International Air and Space Port is 0.60". Total precipitation for 2021 ending April 1st was 0.76", or 1.13" below normal.
