Deep moisture in place over west Texas and several outflow boundaries resulted in an area of showers and thunderstorms persisting through the early morning hours. A severe wind gust was observed at one of the Texas Mesonet sites.

Power poles and trees were blown down. The tree sizes and number of power poles/trees were unknown. Power outages were also reported just west of Colorado City, TX. The property damage for this event was estimated.

A weak cold front draped across the region provided a focus for thunderstorm development during the afternoon and evening hours. An isolated severe wind gust was observed with one of the stronger thunderstorms.
