

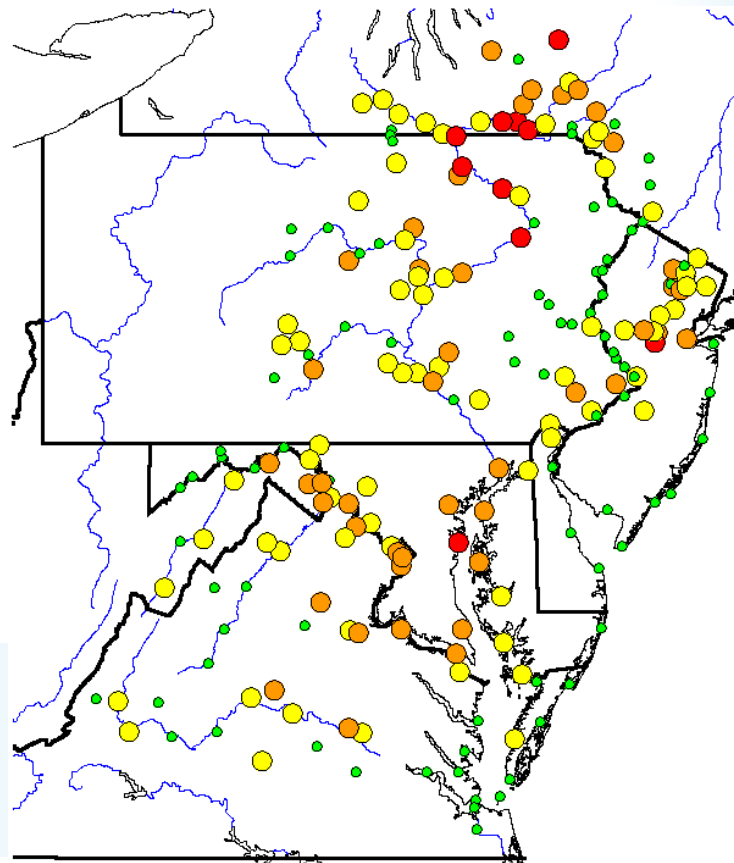

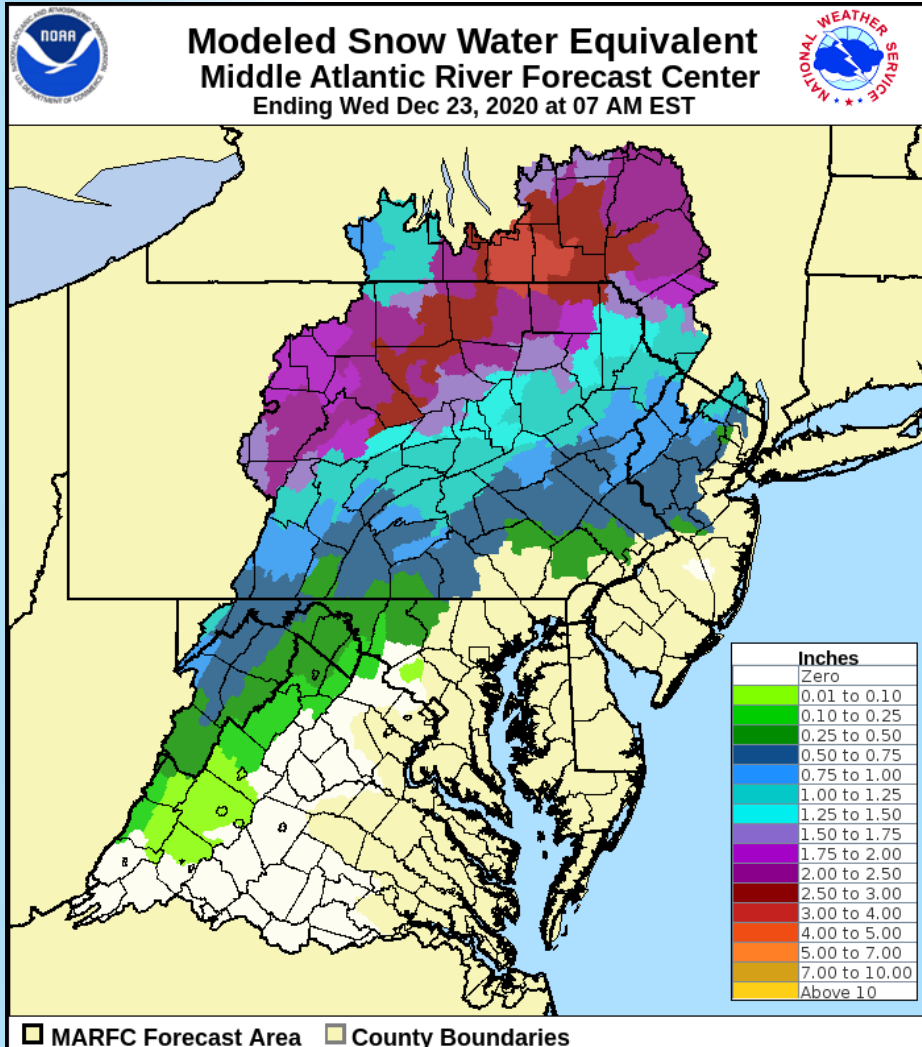

# Main Points

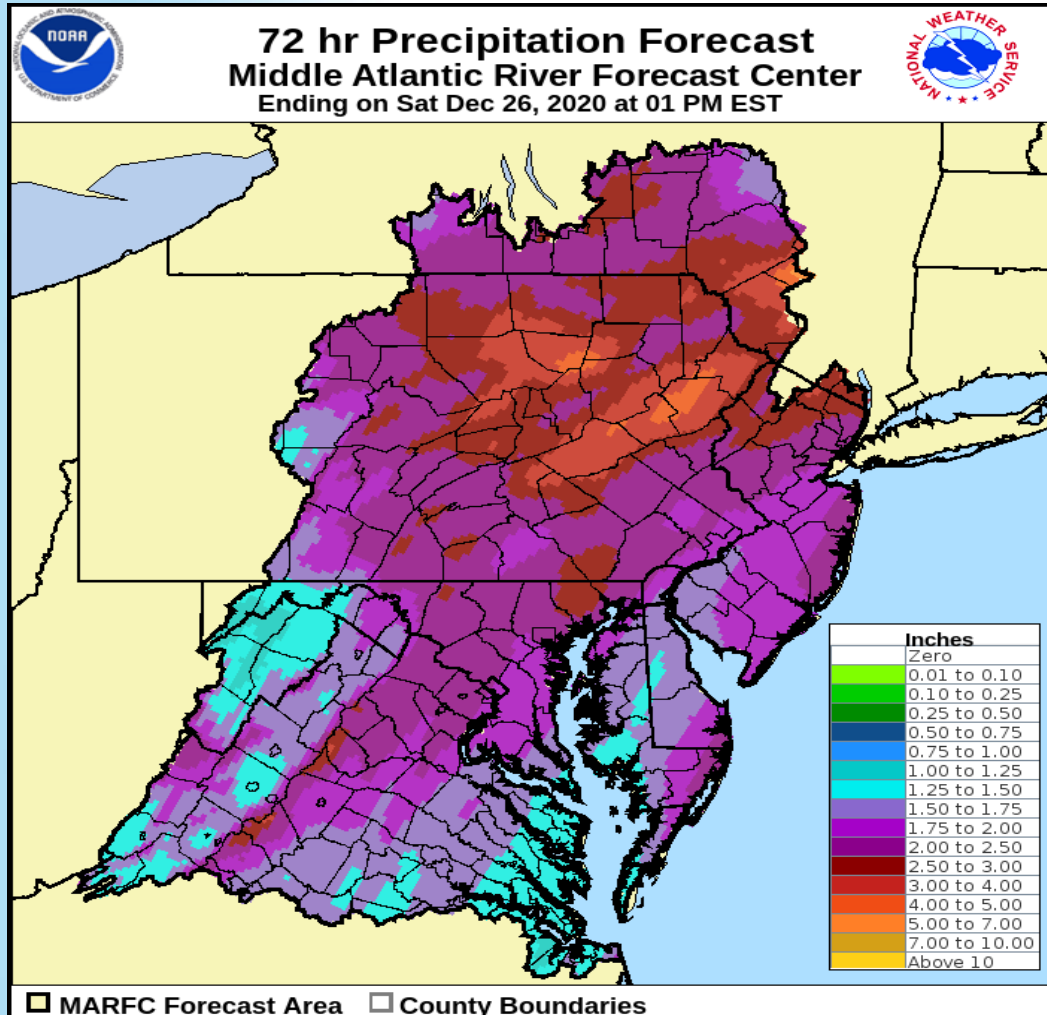
<b>HAZARD:</b>	<b>Widespread minor and moderate flooding is in our 3-day forecasts. Major is possible at isolated locations.</b>
<b>IMPACTS:</b>	Minor and moderate flooding with a chance of major at isolated locations.
<b>LOCATION:</b>	Moderate Flooding: Upper Susquehanna (major possible), main stem Susquehanna, Raritan. Minor Flooding: Susquehanna, Upper Delaware, Passaic, Lower Potomac, Lower James.
<b>TIMING:</b>	Some headwater streams/rivers are expected to reach flood stage early on the morning of 12/25. Medium to larger rivers would crest beginning later on 12/25 continuing into Sunday, 12/27 at downstream locations.
<b>NOTES:</b>	Next briefing will be 12/24 at 12:30 pm. Keep track of latest river forecasts at <a href="https://water.weather.gov">https://water.weather.gov</a>

# Current Snowpack



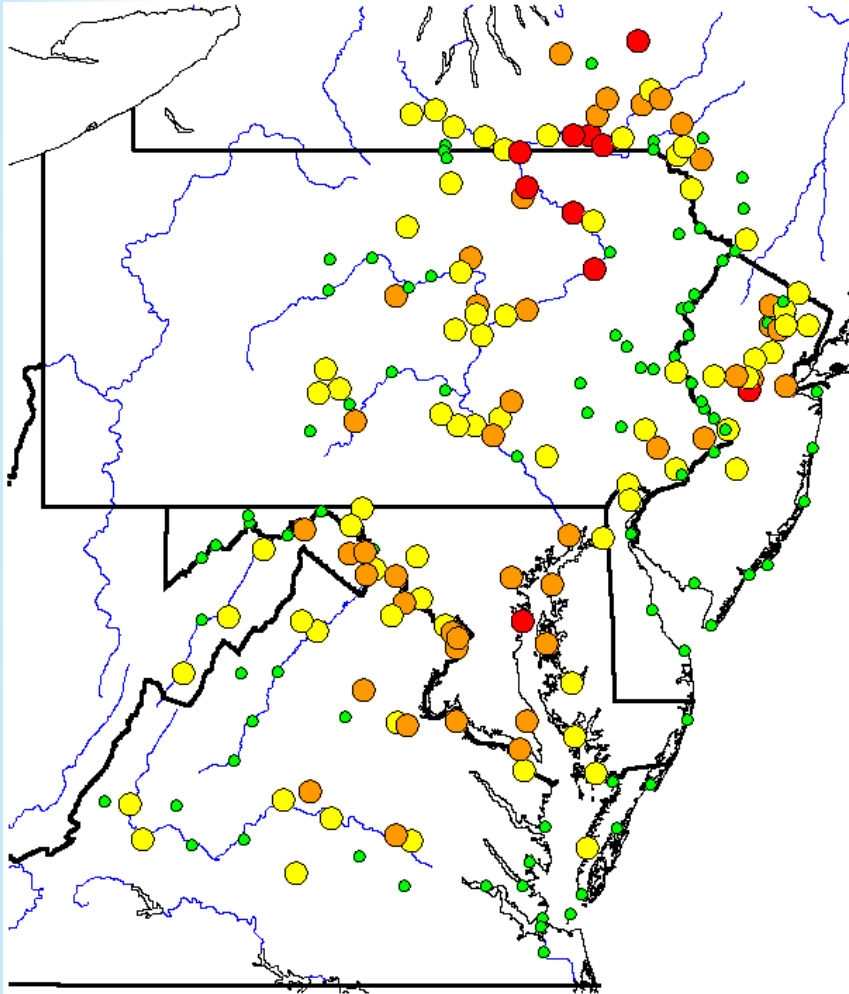
✓ 0.5 to 2.0 inches of snowmelt expected, liquid equivalent

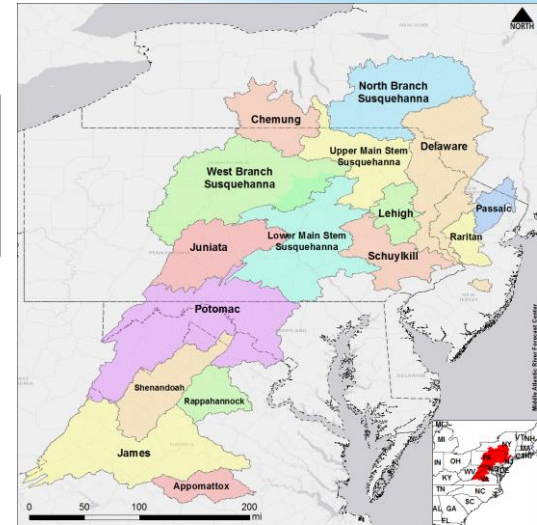
