Weather Summary

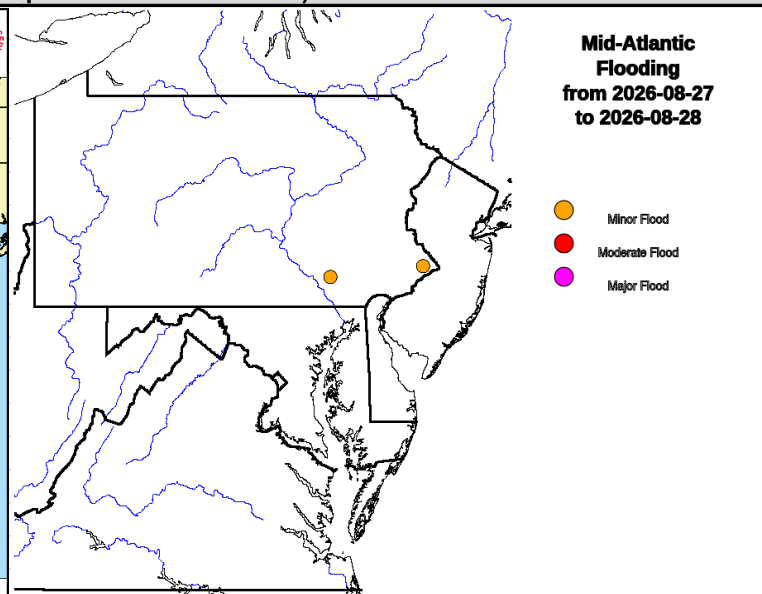
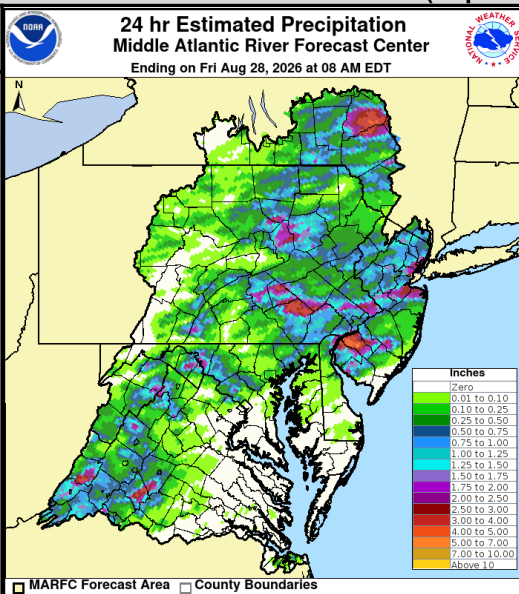
Moisture pooled ahead of a slow-moving cold front, prompting quick downpours from widespread convection. Severe thunderstorms, further fueled by sea breezes and outflow boundaries, yielded rainfall reports of 3-5"+ in several spots from NY to VA, heaviest in southern NJ and southeastern PA. Minor river flooding resulted at two MARFC forecast points: Langhorne, PA and Lancaster, PA.
