Weather Summary

Another low pressure system formed over Canada quickly moved to the Nova Scotia coast. The system intensified and became nearly stationary on July 11. The low was finally pushed out of the region on July 13 as another low pressure system moved up the Atlantic coast. The second low pressure system brought widespread additional rainfall to south central Pennsylvania where rainfall totals ranged from 1 to 2.5 inches. The additional rainfall caused flooding at Shermans Dale, PA.
