17.00	Moderate flooding begins. One to two feet of water on the first floor of the Holiday Mountain Ski and Fun Park chalet. The homes and businesses on holiday Mountain Road surrounded by water. Edwards Road is under water. Water reaches the steps of the gage house.					
15.00	Holiday Mountain Road is inundated. Water reaches the Holiday Mountain Ski and Fun Park chalet.					
13.00	Flood stage where minor flooding begins. The river begins to spread onto the parking lot at the Holiday Mountain Road ski shop.					
12.00	Alert stage. Some field flooding begins on the right bank of the river.
