18.00	Most of Williamsburg is affected by high water. Very few houses on the right bank are above this level.
17.00	Many homes on the right, or south bank are affected by high water. The south approach to the highway bridge is unundated. A number of other streets and roads in the area are closed.
15.00	Many homes on the right, or south bank will be affected by high water.
13.00	Sections of route 866 from Williamsburg to Ganister are covered by flood waters.
12.00	The right, or south bank overflows. The Road near the river upstream of Williamsburg is inundated. A few homes experience basement flooding.
