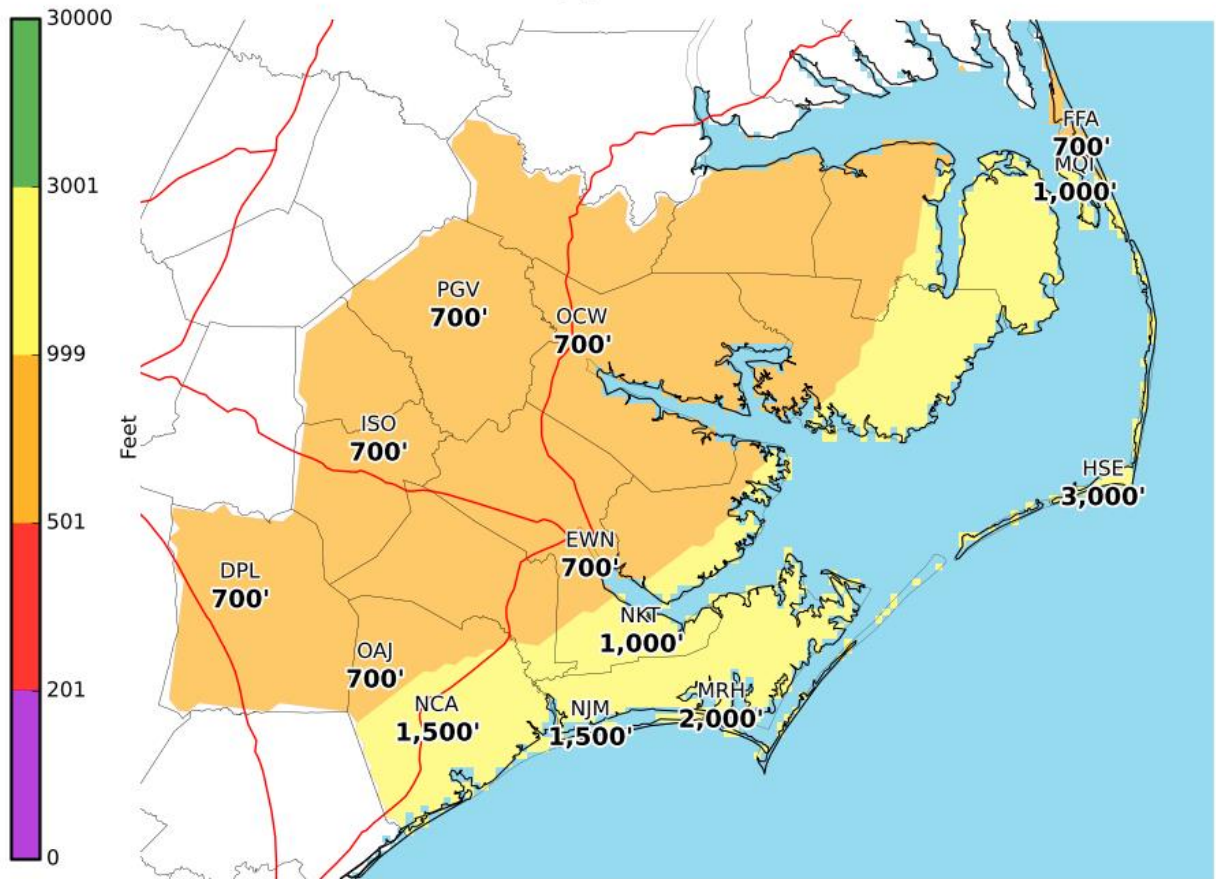


Ceiling, Visibility, and Low Level Wind Shear graphics are now available!

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Locally, the NWS Forecast Office in Newport has the responsibility of issuing Terminal Aerodrome Forecasts (TAFs) for four airports in Eastern North Carolina, including Pitt-Greenville Airpota, Albert J. Ellis Airport, Coastal Carolina Regional Airport and Kinston Regional Jetport.

Recently we have begun digital aviation grids in an effort to better serve our customers beyond just the traditional airport sites. Eventually this information will be able to be viewed graphically as a national mosaic of aviation forecast elements available for the aviation community to utilize in their decision making process.

These new graphics are available every three hours out to twenty four hours, and are updated at least four times a day. The images are color coded by flight category.
