

- Tree limbs could be blown down causing a few power outages.
- Strong southwest winds will create low water conditions on the Neuse River
- Low water levels may impact navigation and ferry service.

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
Coastal Flooding Impacts

- A **Coastal Flood Advisory** is in effect for the Northern Outer Banks and Hatteras Island.
- Up to 2 feet of unundation above ground level is possible in low-lying areas near the shorelines and tidal waterways.
- Some roads and low lying property including parking lots, homes, etc adjacent to the waterfront will experience shallow flooding.
- A second area of concern will be Ocracoke Island as winds shift from southwest to northwest Friday morning.

Moderate Flooding Expected North of Hatteras




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Coastal Flooding Soundside

Minor Flooding Expected

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Newport/Morehead City, NC
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- Strong southwest winds Thursday and Thursday night will cause minor coastal flooding on the soundside especially from Hatteras Island North.
- Some roads and low lying property including parking lots, homes, etc adjacent to the waterfront will experience shallow flooding.
- As southwest winds shift into the northwest Friday (7 AM to Noon), water level rises are expected on soundside areas of Ocracoke and the rest of Hatteras Island.

High Risk of Rip Currents



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
Rip Current Risk

Rough Surf and Longshore Current Expected



High	Powerful or numerous rip currents. Everyone should stay out of the water.
Moderate	Only experienced swimmers who know how to escape a rip current should enter the surf.
Low	Rip currents still possible. Always swim near a lifeguard.



- Strong wind and large waves expected especially south facing beaches.
- Dangerous and life threatening surf expected.

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
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Isolated Severe Storms Possible
