County Name Baldwin	Injuries: 6	Fatalities: 0 direct 0 indirect	Evacuations: None
At least 22 water rescues from rip currents on the 23rd on Fort Morgan. Of this number, six were hospitalized. The eastbound lanes of the Causeway over Mobile Bay were closed for approximately 5 hours due to minor inundation and debris from the coastal flooding. Gulf State Park Pier was closed due to several walking tiles on the pier popping up due to wave action from the storm.

Dauphin Island Parkway just north of the Dog River Bridge was closed for approximately 5-6 hours due to minor inundation and debris from coastal flooding. Inundation and debris from coastal flooding were also noted on the low-lying coastal roads in Bayou La Batre. Saltwater of at least 1 ft deep was observed on Bienville Blvd on the west end of Dauphin Island.

The campground at Fort Pickens inside the Gulf Islands National Seashore was closed for several days due to sand and saltwater covering the first 5 miles of the road. In the Pensacola area, the boardwalk at Sanders Beach was damaged, along with damage to the seawall and some signs blown over. The boat launch, docks, and pier at Bayview Park were underwater, and the floating kayak launch separated from the boardwalk. The boat launch and docks at Bayou Texar were underwater. There was some minor limb damage along the Osceola Golf Course, and the Navy Pelican at Palafox and Garden Streets was damaged and knocked off its base. Several downed trees across the Pensacola metro area briefly closed roads.
