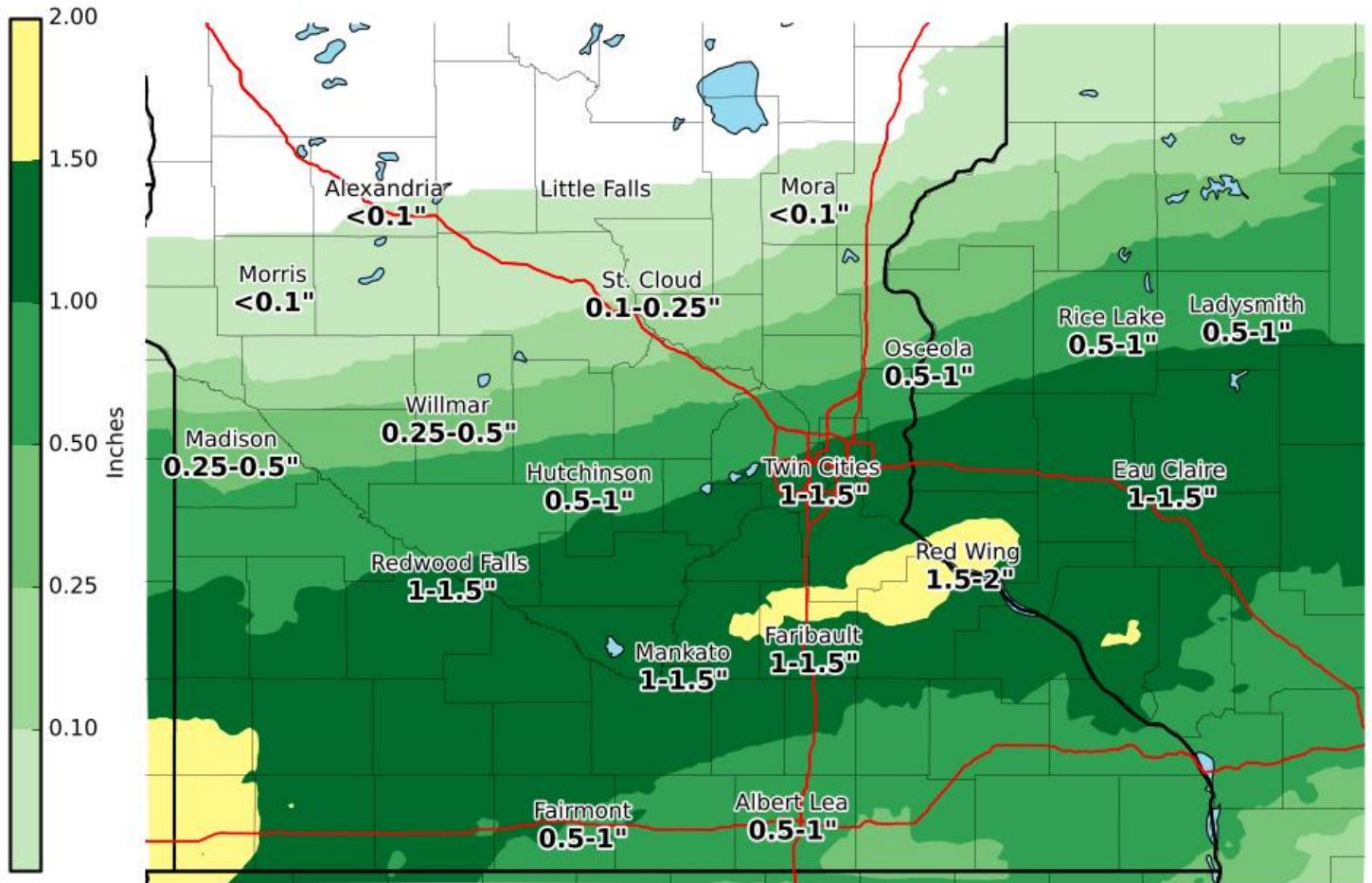




Flooding Possible Tonight through Friday Morning

Message of the Day:



Thunderstorms are likely this evening through the overnight hours across Southern MN and West Central WI. Widespread rainfall of 1 to 2 inches with localized heavier amounts likely which may lead to flash flooding. There is also a chance for scattered severe storms capable of producing 58+ mph winds.

Important Forecast Changes



A Flash Flood Watch has been issued for Southwestern MN where the soils are still moist from rainfall over the last 2 weeks.



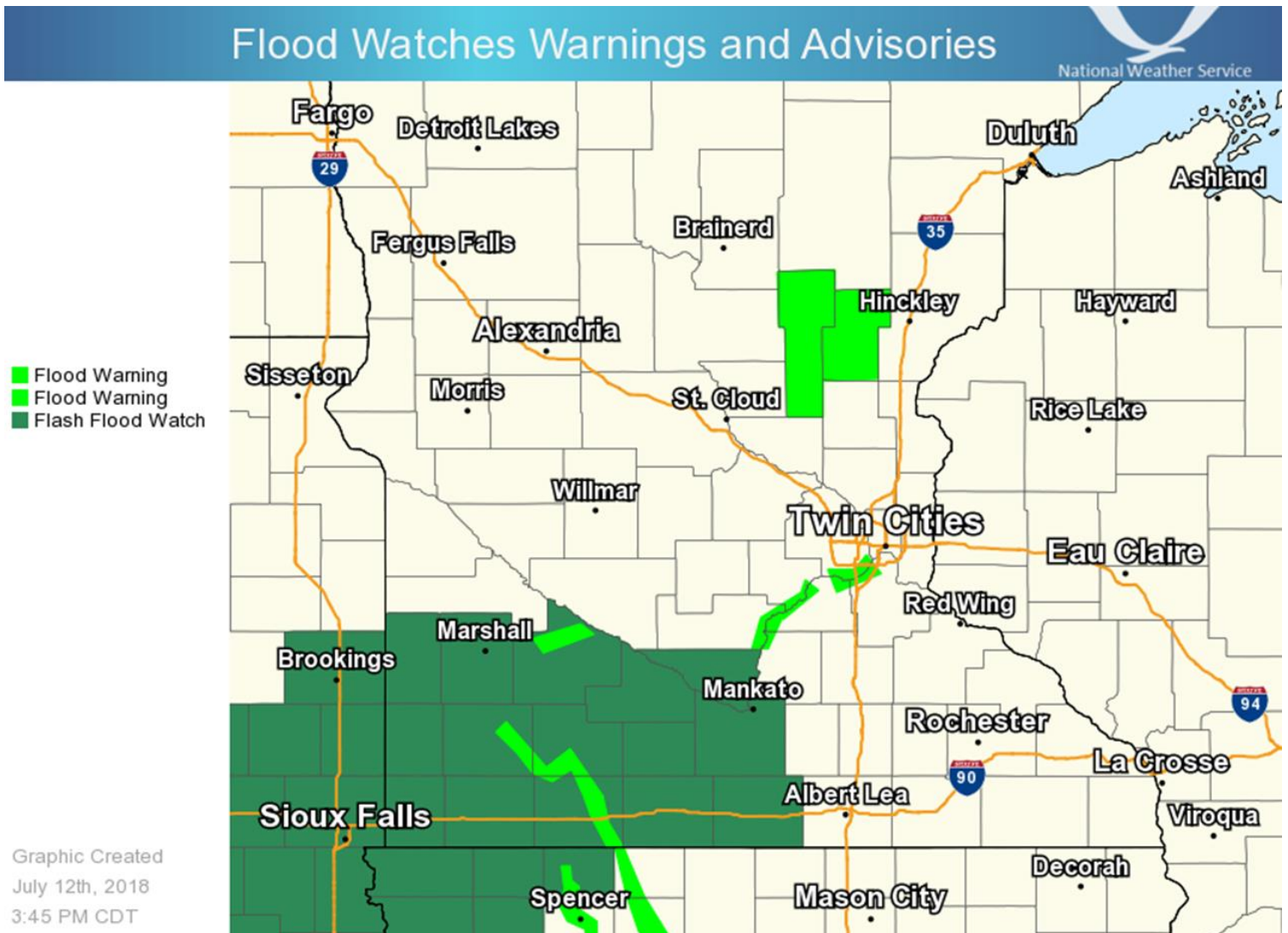
Flooding Possible Tonight through Friday Morning

- Widespread 1 to 2 inch rainfall with localized heavier amounts may lead to flooding, especially in urban areas as well as along rivers and streams.

- Tonight through Friday Morning



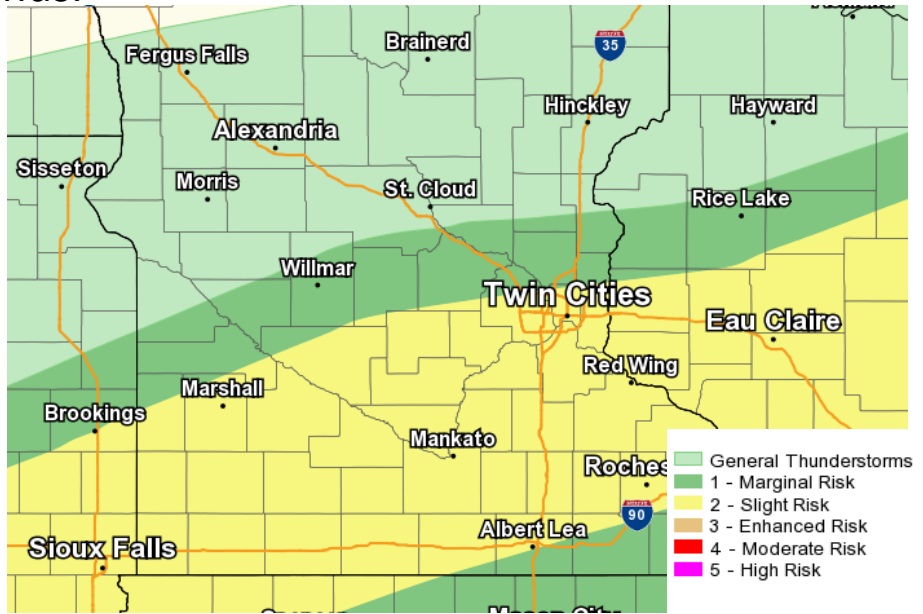


Message of the Day:
