              Wisconsin

The NWS Weather Forecast Office (WFO) in Green Bay, WI, (KGRB) has completed the move of the Upper Air inflation shelter. After four weeks, the Upper Air observations have resumed August 18, 2020, from the new release point.

Please update your metadata files as soon as possible so your Upper Air derived products will not give erroneous information.
