Subject: Soliciting Comments on a Proposal to Discontinue Small Craft Exercise Caution Headline through August 13, 2021

The NWS is proposing this change for several reasons. First, the SCEC headline does not have associated Valid Time Event Code (VTEC) encoding to accompany the headline issuance for alerting purposes. Second, the detailed forecast information within the product will not change within the coastal waters forecast products for a mariner to make a prudent decision. Finally, the Southern Region NWS Coastal Forecast Offices are

only the offices that issue this headline and the NWS is seeking to simplify our products and communicate threats more clearly and consistently. $\,$
