2019, a security update to the Environmental Systems Research Institute's  
(ESRI's) ArcGIS platform will degrade functionality on the NWS forecast  
application below:

The forecast application leverages ESRI's online GeoCoding service. On  
or about April 16, 2019, functionality on the forecast application that  
highlights forecast locations will not appear for users of Internet  
Explorer 9 and 10.
