Imagery Composite Products from the NOAAPort/SBN: Effective December 10,
2020

Effective on or about Thursday, December 10, 2020, the Satellite Broadcast
Network (SBN) will cease disseminating legacy Global Multi-Satellite
Geostationary Imagery Composite products, which are in GOES Ingest
NOAAPort Interface (GINI) format. These products are as follows:

Imagery Composite to be deactivated -----	WMO Header -----
Visible	TICF01 KNES
Water Vapor	TICF03 KNES
Longwave Infrared	TICF04 KNES

Users of these legacy products should transition to the new netCDF Global
Multi-Satellite Geostationary Imagery Composite products, which have been
available via SBN (NOAAPort_OPT Channel: Port 1204, PID 104) since
September 16, 2020:

Active Replacement Imagery Composite -----	WMO Header -----
Visible	TICF02 KNES
Water Vapor	TICF08 KNES
Longwave Infrared	TICF14 KNES
