Effective Thursday, April 9, 2020, the Spanish translation of the National Hurricane Center's (NHC's) Tropical Cyclone Discussion (TCD) product for the Atlantic Basin will be discontinued. This product will no longer be available from the NHC webpage at hurricanes.gov or from the NWS San Juan website at the following URL:
