Subject: Change to Global Aviation Products related to the World Area Forecast System (WAFS) Product on or about January 17, 2024

Effective on or about January 17, 2024 at 1200 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the National Centers for Environmental Prediction (NCEP) Central Operations (NCO) will stop distributing selected aviation-hazard products from the World Area Forecast System (WAFS). Users should switch to accessing these products through the WAFS Internet File Service (WIFS) at <a href="https://aviationweather.gov/wifs/">https://aviationweather.gov/wifs/</a>, where they will remain available. This update is occurring as a result of International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), Annex 3 requirements and international agreements.
