Station WXM82, Egremont, Massachusetts: Effective on or before February
28, 2025

Effective on or before February 28, 2025, NWR service from WXM82, with a
transmitter located in Egremont, Massachusetts and previously operating
on a frequency of 162.450 Megahertz (MHz), will be terminated as the site
location will no longer be available for use.
