Subject: Probabilistic Tropical Cyclone Storm Surge (P-Surge) Model
Testing June 11 and 12, 2026

On June 11 and 12, 2026, the National Hurricane Center (NHC) and National Weather Service (NWS) Central Operations (NCO) will conduct a Probabilistic Tropical Storm (P-Surge) model test. The test will be conducted between 1400 and 1600 UTC and will focus on testing dataflow.
