Subject: Implementation of Terminal Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) Service for
Frenchville Airport (KFVE) in Northern ME: Effective April 11, 2012

Note: The following changes have no impact on NOAA Weather Wire Service
Subscribers.

Effective Wednesday April 11, 2012, at 1800 Coordinated Universal Time
(UTC), the NWS office in Caribou, ME will begin TAF service for the
Frenchville airport (KFVE) in northern Maine. Routine and updated TAFs
will be issued for this airport 24 hours per day.

NWS personnel will need to add the following identifier to their
Communications systems to receive the new TAF:
