Amended to extend the comment period through April 7, 2017.

NWS is seeking user comments on the Adaptable NWS Forecast/Observation Widget through April 7, 2017. The NWS is testing a new Widget and Adaptable Web Page service. The service brings together NWS forecast and warning data in a package that allows web developers to embed NWS information in their pages quickly and easily as a widget. In addition, the same code, when viewed in a web browser on device (e.g., smartphones, tablets and desktop computers), will adapt automatically to the screen's size.
