NWS is accepting comments through April 1, 2015, on an  
experimental service to disseminate credible, relevant and timely  
public safety information from other government agencies before,  
during and after high impact weather, water and climate events  
through NWS Special Weather Statement or Public Information  
Statements products.

Joining with other government agencies to communicate weather-  
related public safety information bolsters the collective effort  
to ensure the public is prepared for high impact weather, water  
and climate events. Through its existing expansive delivery  
infrastructure, NWS can significantly elevate awareness of  
serious threats such as, but not limited to, carbon monoxide  
poisoning from generator use during power outages, harmful mold  
exposure during or after flooding, and heat stroke during heat  
waves.
