SOUTHEAST NEW YORK...EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 14 2000

ON TUESDAY NOVEMBER 14 2000...AT 400 PM EST...THE NATIONAL
WEATHER SERVICE OFFICE AT UPTON NEW YORK WILL BEGIN ISSUING A NEW
TYPE OF STATE FORECAST FOR EXTREME SOUTHEAST NEW YORK. THE NEW
FORECAST WILL PROVIDE MORE SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR VARIOUS
CITIES AND TOWNS IN THE STATE IN A TABULAR FORMAT...OUT TO FIVE
DAYS. A NARRATIVE STATE FORECAST WILL FOLLOW THE TABULAR DATA
FOR 60 DAYS...THEN BE PHASED OUT ON JANUARY 12 2001.

FORECASTS FOR ADDITIONAL CITIES OR TOWNS CAN BE ADDED TO THE
TABULAR VERSION TO SUIT SPECIFIC BROADCAST AREAS...AS CAN
FORECASTS FOR RECREATIONAL AREAS OR OTHER SITES OF WIDESPREAD
INTEREST.

THE WMO HEADER AND AWIPS IDENTIFIER FOR THE STATE FORECAST FOR
EXTREME SOUTHEAST NEW YORK ARE UNCHANGED...AND REMAIN FPUS61 KOKX
AND SFPNY. THE PIL IDENTIFIER IS ALSO UNCHANGED...AND REMAINS
NYCSFPNY.

CONCERNING THE STATE FORECAST PRODUCT FOR NEW YORK STATE...THE
NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE OFFICE AT ALBANY NY BEGAN ISSUING THIS
NEW FORMAT FOR CENTRAL AND EASTERN NEW YORK STATE ON

JUNE 8 2000. THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE OFFICE AT BUFFALO NY
