EFFECTIVE JANUARY 31 2007 NWS WILL TERMINATE THE NATIONAL
HYDROLOGIC SUMMARY /WMO HEADER FGUS71 KWBC/. COMMENTS WERE
COLLECTED ON THE PROPOSED TERMINATION FROM AUGUST 23 2006 UNTIL
SEPTEMBER 30 2006. AFTER EVALUATION OF THESE COMMENTS NWS
DECIDED TO TERMINATE THE NATIONAL HYDROLOGIC SUMMARY ON JANUARY
31 2007.
