CENTRAL DAYLIGHT TIME /CDT/...1800 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME /UTC/...THE EL PASO AREA /EPZ/ WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE /WFO/ WILL BEGIN PROVIDING FIRE WEATHER FORECAST AND FIRE WEATHER WARNING PRODUCTS FOR THE TEXAS COUNTIES OF EL PASO AND HUDSPETH. THIS SERVICE IS BEING PROVIDED AT THE REQUEST OF LAND MANAGEMENT AGENCIES AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OFFICIALS AND REQUIRES THE ADDITION OF TWO FIRE WEATHER ZONES /TXZ055 AND TXZ056/ DESCRIBED BELOW IN TABLE 1.
