NOAA/S NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE /NWS/ PROVIDES AVIATION WEATHER PRODUCTS ACCORDING TO FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION /FAA/ REQUIREMENTS. FAA ORDER 7110.10S...FLIGHT SERVICES...DATED FEBRUARY 16 2006 SUMMARY OF CHANGES STATES TWEBS WILL ONLY BE PROVIDED IN ALASKA. THE FAA HAS STATED NO REQUIREMENT FOR CONTIGUOUS U.S. /CONUS/ TWEB FORECASTS ONCE THE AUTOMATED FLIGHT SERVICE STATIONS CEASE FUNCTIONING AND LOCKHEED-MARTIN CONTRACT FLIGHT SERVICE FACILITIES REACH FULL OPERATIONAL STATUS ON JULY 31 2007.

A PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ABOUT ENDING CONUS TWEB FORECASTS ENDED MAY 20 2007 WITH A RESPONSE FROM LESS THAN 1 PERCENT OF POTENTIALLY AFFECTED GENERAL AVIATION PILOTS.

AN ANALYSIS OF COMMENTS SHOWED THAT THE TWEB IS NOT USED BY THE MAJORITY OF GENERAL AVIATORS IN ADDITION TO BEING NOT REQUIRED BY THE FAA. THEREFORE...THE NWS WILL CEASE PRODUCING THE TWEB AT 0000 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME /UTC/ SEPTEMBER 30 2007. THE NWS POLICY DIRECTIVE SYSTEM (PDS) 10-805...TRANSCRIBED WEATHER BROADCASTS...WILL BE UPDATED ACCORDINGLY. AN EXAMPLE OF THE TWEB PRODUCT WHICH IS BEING TERMINATED IS AS FOLLOWS:
