WILL BEGIN ISSUING A SURF ZONE FORECAST /SRF/.

THE SURF ZONE IS THE AREA OF WATER BETWEEN THE HIGH WATER
/OR TIDE/ LEVEL ON THE BEACH AND THE SEAWARD SIDE OF
BREAKING WAVES. THE SRF HAS BEEN ISSUED BY SELECT COASTAL
WFOS SINCE 2002. WSO BARROW WILL BE THE FIRST ALASKA OFFICE
TO ISSUE THE SURF ZONE FORECAST.
