Subject: Discontinuance of the Arkansas State Forecast Product (SFPAR) in Favor of Individual WFO Tabular State Forecast Products (SFTXXX): Effective January 3, 2013

Effective Thursday, January 3, 2013, at 600 AM Central Standard Time (CST), 1200 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the NWS Weather Forecast Office (WFO) in Little Rock (LZK), AR, will stop issuing the State Forecast Product (SFPAR) for the state of Arkansas (Table 1).
