Subject: Discontinuance of the Quantitative Precipitation Forecast Western
Region Points Products: Effective July 15, 2015

Effective Wednesday, July 15, 2015, at 1800 Coordinated Universal Time
(UTC), the National Centers for Environmental Prediction (NCEP) Weather
Prediction Center (WPC) will discontinue the Quantitative Precipitation
Forecast (QPF) Western Region Points products.

Through coordination with the NWS Western Region River Forecast Centers
(RFCs), the WPC determined that the RFCs no longer use the products listed
below in Table 1. The RFCs determined the WPC gridded data served their
purposes better than these text products.
