Subject: Discontinuation of Tides On Line (TOL) Coastal Observation
Product at NOS/CO-OPS: Effective October 16, 2017

Effective October 16, 2017, at 1300 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) (9AM
EST), the NOAA/NOS TOL Product will be discontinued by NOS/CO-OPS:

The TOL product displays coastal near real time observations of water
level, winds, water and air temperature and atmospheric pressure from
NOS/CO-OPS National Water Level Observation Network (NWLON) stations.
There are no changes to the NWLON observing system, but the TOL display
has become redundant with newer data dissemination pathways at:
