/KCAR/ MAINE...EFFECTIVE JANUARY 8 2000

EFFECTIVE SATURDAY...JANUARY 8 AT 0000 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME  
/UTC/.../TONIGHT/...THE NWS OFFICE IN CARIBOU MAINE WILL EXPAND THE  
TERMINAL AERODROME FORECAST /TAF/ FOR THE CARIBOU MUNICIPAL AIRPORT /KCAR/  
TO 24 HOUR COVERAGE. VALID TIMES FOR ROUTINE AND AMENDED TAF  
ISSUANCES...WHICH PREVIOUSLY EXTENDED ONLY FROM 1200 UTC UNTIL 0200  
UTC...WILL NOW COVER A FULL 24 HOUR PERIOD.

THIS CHANGE WILL NOT REQUIRE ANY ACTION FROM NWS PERSONNEL...FEDERAL  
AVIATION ADMINISTRATION /FAA/ PERSONNEL OR EXTERNAL CUSTOMERS. THERE WILL  
BE NO CHANGE IN THE COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL...INCLUDING AUTOMATION OF FIELD  
OPERATIONS AND SERVICES /AFOS/ IDENTIFIERS...WORLD METEOROLOGICAL  
ORGANIZATION /WMO/ HEADERS AND COLLECTIVES IN WHICH THE TAFS ARE  
CONTAINED. IN ADDITION...HOLDERS OF WEATHER SERVICES OPERATIONS MANUAL  
/WSOM/ CHAPTER D-31 /AVIATION TERMINAL FORECASTS/ ARE NOT REQUIRED TO MAKE  
ANY CHANGES TO APPENDICES A OR B.
