EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY...SEPTEMBER 27 2000 AT 0000 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME
/UTC/...THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE /NWS/ OFFICE IN SEATTLE WASHINGTON
WILL EXTEND TERMINAL AERODROME FORECAST /TAF/ SERVICE FOR SNOHOMISH COUNTY
AIRPORT /PAINE FIELD/ IN EVERETT WASHINGTON /KPAE/ TO 24 HOUR COVERAGE.
ALSO AT THAT TIME...THE NWS OFFICE IN SPOKANE WASHINGTON WILL EXTEND TAF
SERVICE AT GRANT COUNTY AIRPORT IN MOSES LAKE WASHINGTON /KMWH/ TO 24
HOURS. BOTH ROUTINE AND UPDATED TAFS...WHICH HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN ISSUED
ON A PART-TIME BASIS...WILL NOW BE ISSUED 24 HOURS A DAY.

THIS CHANGE WILL NOT REQUIRE ANY ACTION FROM NWS PERSONNEL...FEDERAL
AVIATION ADMINISTRATION /FAA/ PERSONNEL OR EXTERNAL CUSTOMERS. THERE WILL
BE NO CHANGE IN THE COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL...INCLUDING AUTOMATION OF FIELD
OPERATIONS AND SERVICES /AFOS/ IDENTIFIERS...WORLD METEOROLOGICAL
ORGANIZATION /WMO/ HEADERS...NOR THE COLLECTIVES IN WHICH EITHER OF THESE
TAFS IS CONTAINED. IN ADDITION...HOLDERS OF WEATHER SERVICE OPERATIONS
MANUAL /WSOM/ CHAPTER D-31 /AVIATION TERMINAL FORECASTS/ ARE NOT REQUIRED
TO MAKE ANY CHANGES TO APPENDICES.
