EFFECTIVE TUESDAY NOVEMBER 6 2007 AT 1015 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL
TIME /UTC/...FOR HIGH LEVEL SIGNIFICANT WEATHER /SWH/ AND MEDIUM
LEVEL SIGNIFICANT WEATHER /SWM/ FORECASTS VALID NOVEMBER 7 2007
AT 0000 UTC... WAFS SWH AND SWM BUFR AND PNG PRODUCTS WILL NO
LONGER CONTAIN SURFACE FRONTS AND INTER TROPICAL CONVERGENCE
ZONES /ITCZ/. SWM BUFR AND PNG PRODUCTS WILL NO LONGER CONTAIN
NON-CUMULONIMBUS CLOUD TYPE AND COVERAGE.

SWH AND SWM BUFR FILES JUJE00 KKCI AND JUF E00 KKCI WILL CONTINUE
TO BE SENT BUT WILL CONTAIN NO DATA.
