EFFECTIVE TUESDAY NOVEMBER 20 2007 AT 1200 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME
/UTC/...THE NWS OFFICE IN MIDLAND TEXAS WILL BEGIN TAF SERVICE FOR PECOS
MUNICIPAL AIRPORT /KPEQ/ IN PECOS TEXAS. BOTH ROUTINE AND UPDATED TAFS
WILL BE ISSUED FOR THIS AIRPORT 24 HOURS A DAY.
