TIME /UTC/...THE NWS OFFICE IN JACKSONVILLE FLORIDA WILL BEGIN  
TAF SERVICE FOR CECIL FIELD AIRPORT /KVQQ/ IN JACKSONVILLE  
FLORIDA. BOTH ROUTINE AND UPDATED TAFS WILL BE ISSUED FOR THIS  
AIRPORT 24 HOURS A DAY.
