SUBJECT: Implementation of Terminal Aerodrome
Forecast (TAF) Service for Lancaster Airport
Effective March 23, 2011.

Effective Wednesday, March 23, 2011, at 0000 Universal
Coordinated Time (UTC), the NWS office at State College, PA,
will begin TAF service for Lancaster Airport (KLNS) in
Pennsylvania. After that date, routine and updated TAFS will be
issued for this airport 24 hours a day.

to their communications systems to receive the new TAF.
