Effective Wednesday, March 23, 2011, at 0000 Universal
Coordinated Time (UTC), the NWS office at Blacksburg, VA, will
begin TAF service for Virginia Tech/Montgomery Executive Airport
(KBCB) in Virginia. After that date, routine and updated TAFS
will be issued for this airport 24 hours a day.
